

Methodology

The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted from Wednesday, March 11th to Friday, March 13th, 2026, among a sample of 1,054 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in British Columbia. The survey was conducted using automated telephone interviews (Smart IVR) and text message to online survey. Respondents were interviewed on landlines and cellular phones. The survey is intended to represent the voting population in British Columbia.

The margin of error for the poll is +/- 3% at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample. Totals may not add up to 100% due to rounding.



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


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

Model Summary

Only 1 of 5 BC Conservative leadership scenarios — Milobar — projects a Conservative majority government. The remaining scenarios project NDP majorities, driven by razor-thin margins between the Conservatives and NDP among decided voters. Milobar projects the strongest Conservative result at 53 seats. The Conservatives hold the Interior firmly in all scenarios; the election is decided in competitive Metro Vancouver, North Shore, and Vancouver Island clusters.
