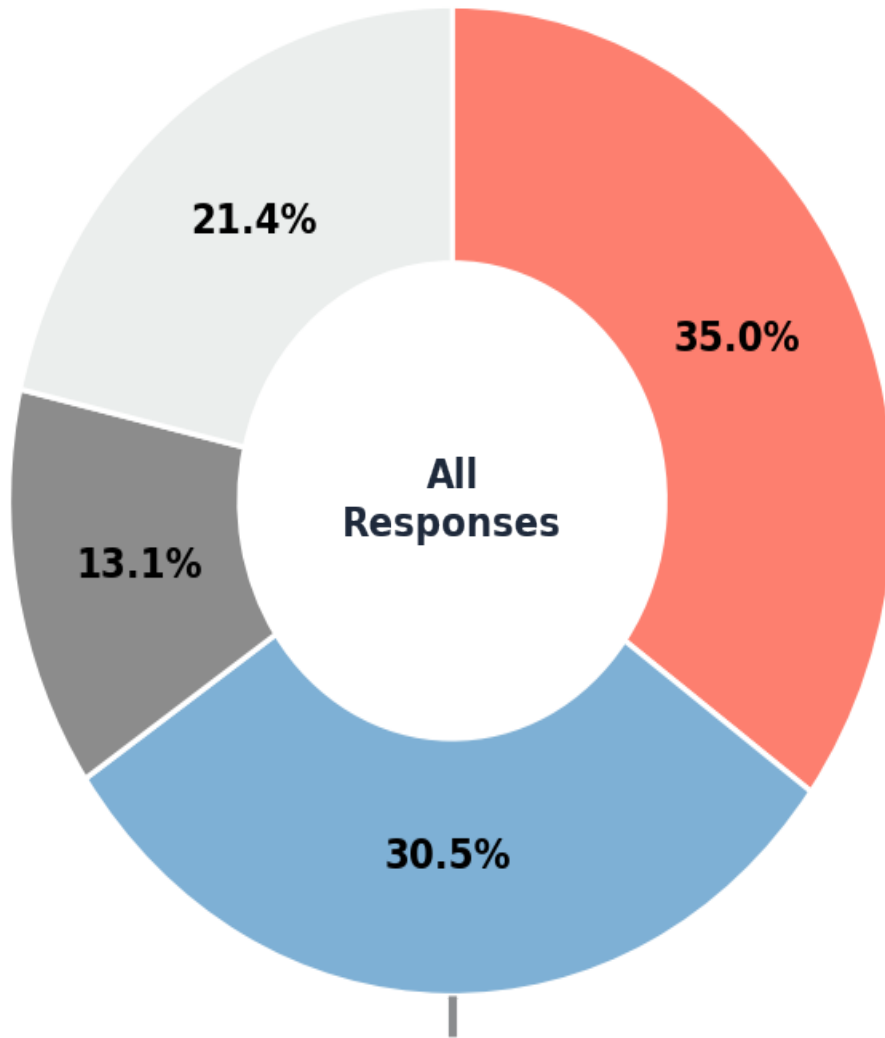

Methodology

The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted June 12-18th, 2026, among a sample of 1157 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in Toronto. The survey was conducted using SMS to online survey and IVR. Respondents were interviewed on landlines and cellular phones. The survey is intended to represent the voting population in Toronto. The margin of error for the poll is +/- 2.9% at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample. Totals may not add up 100% due to rounding. 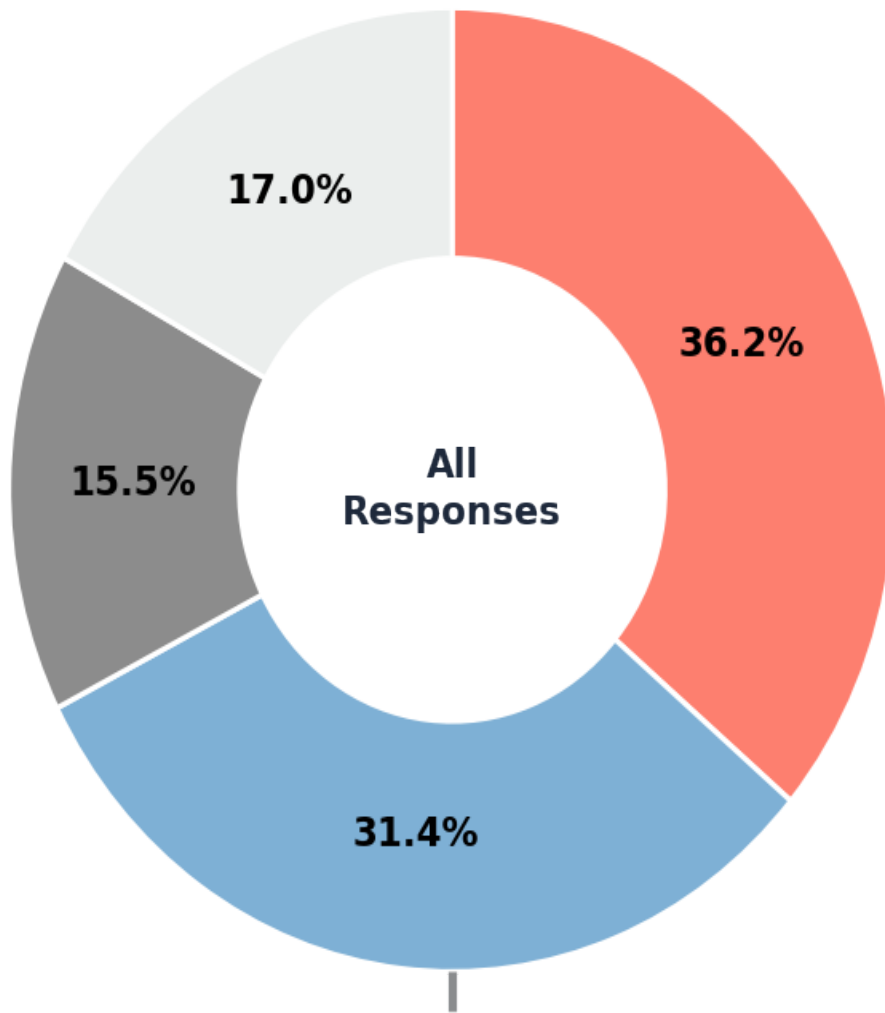

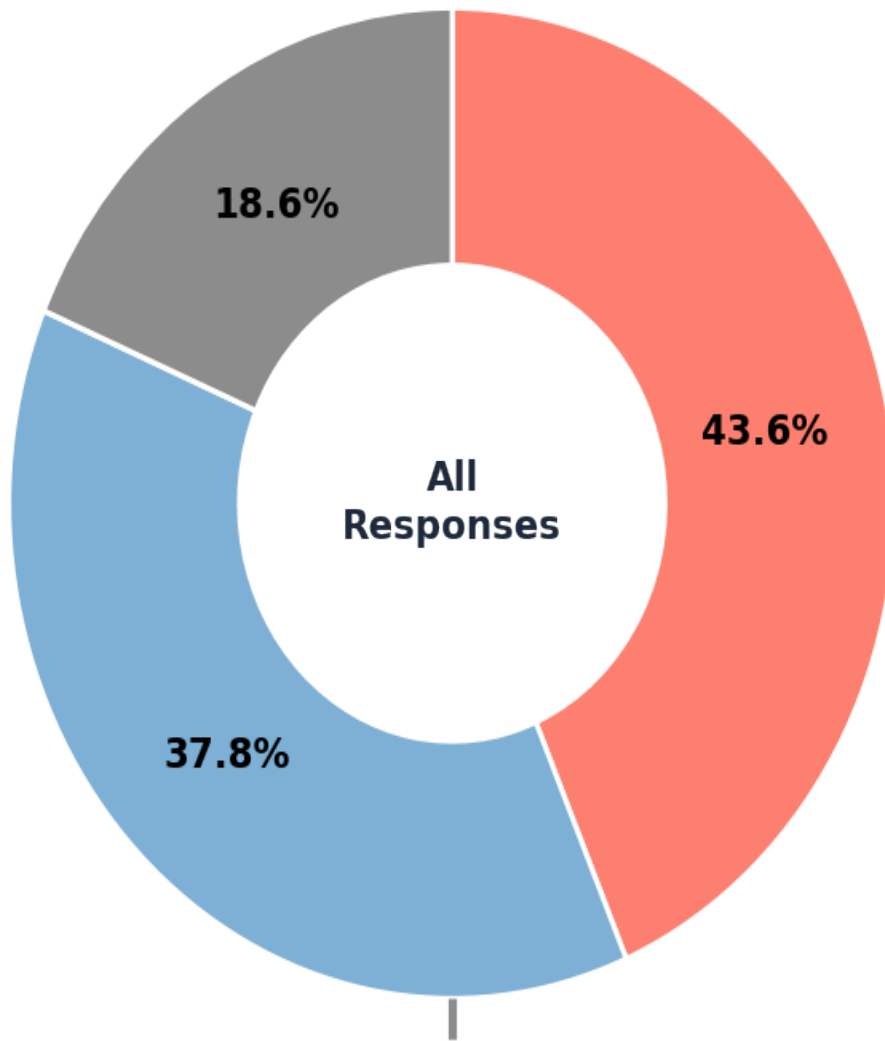

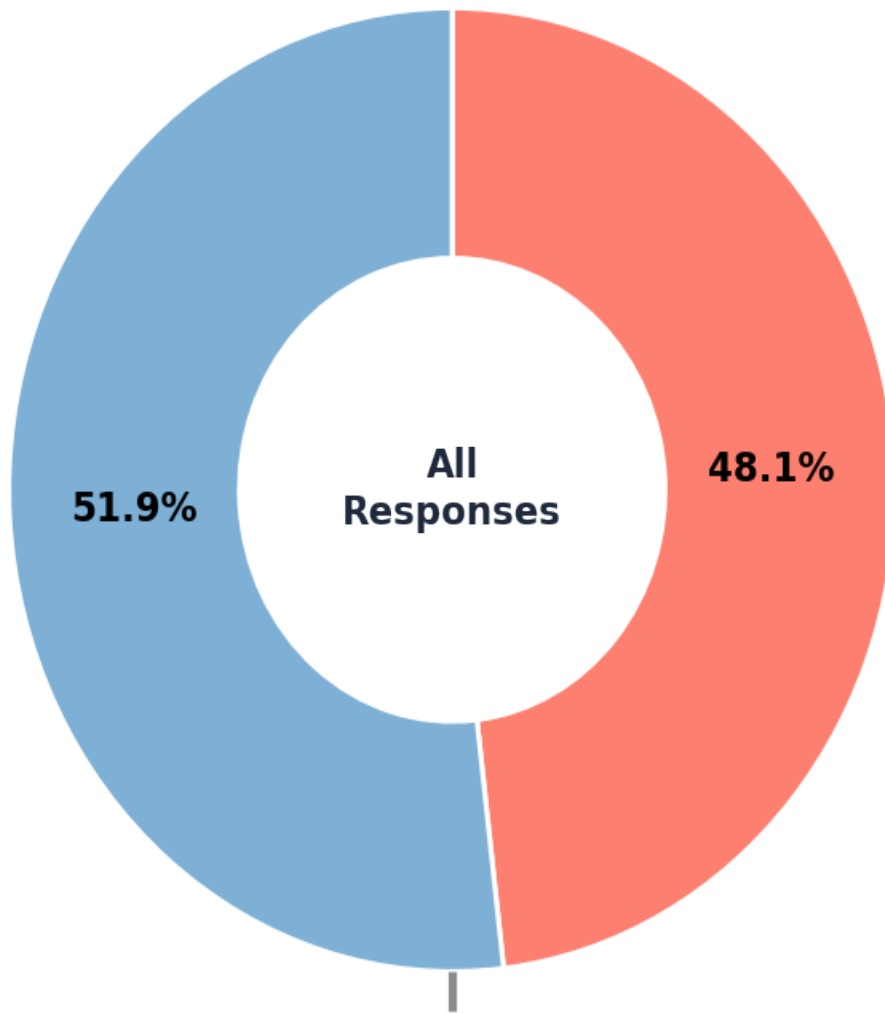

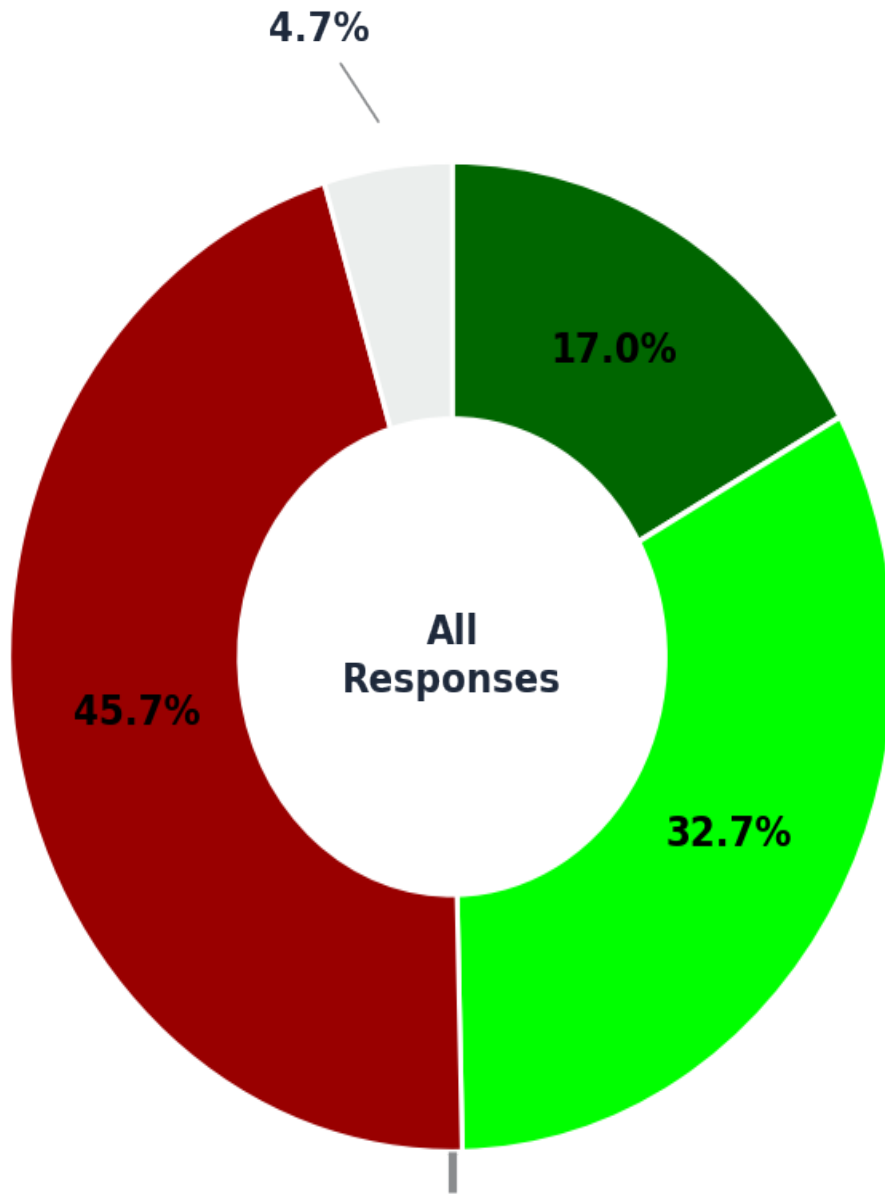

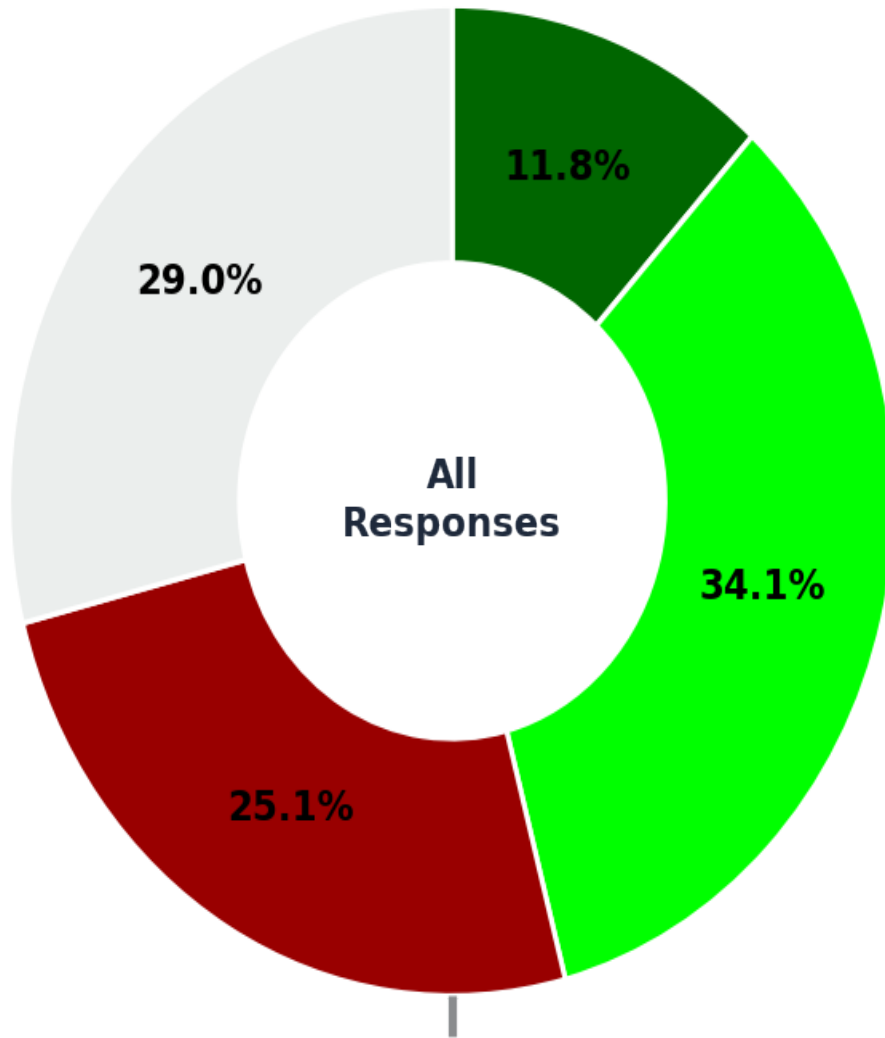

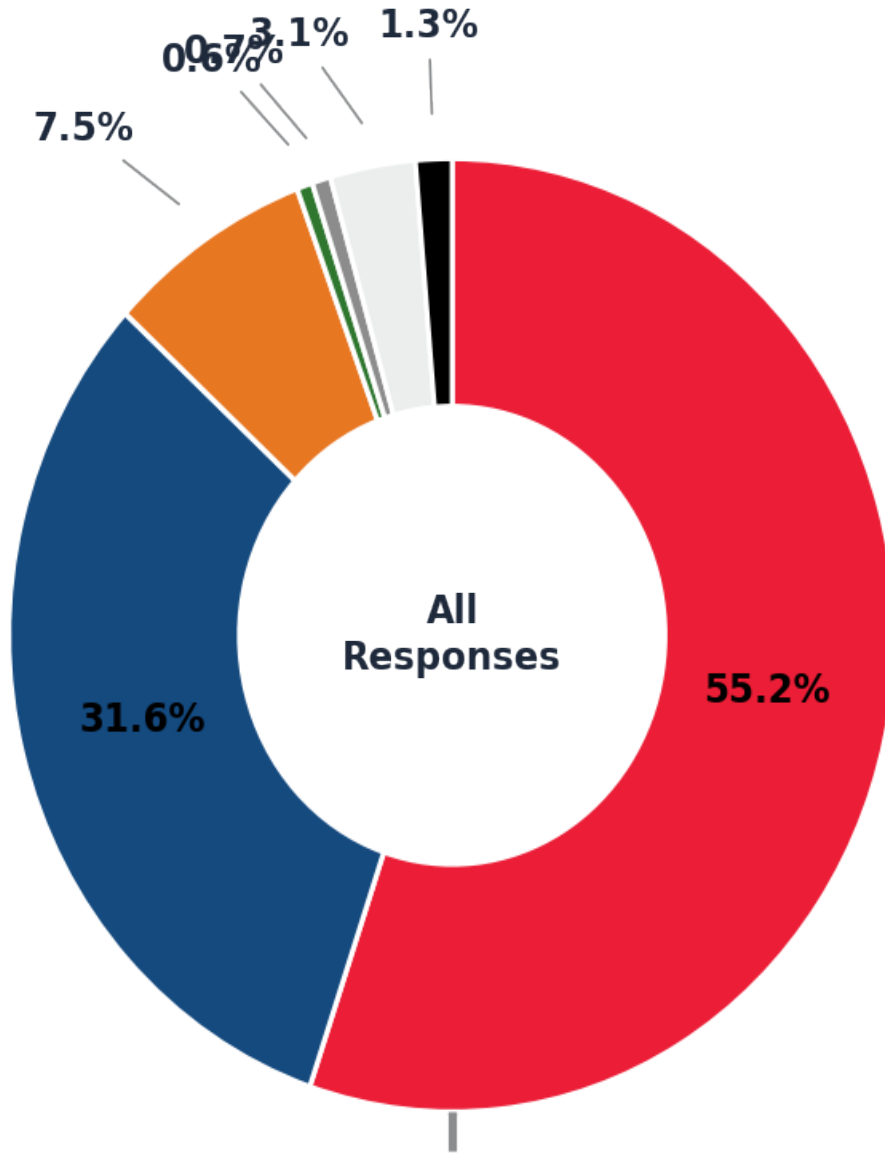

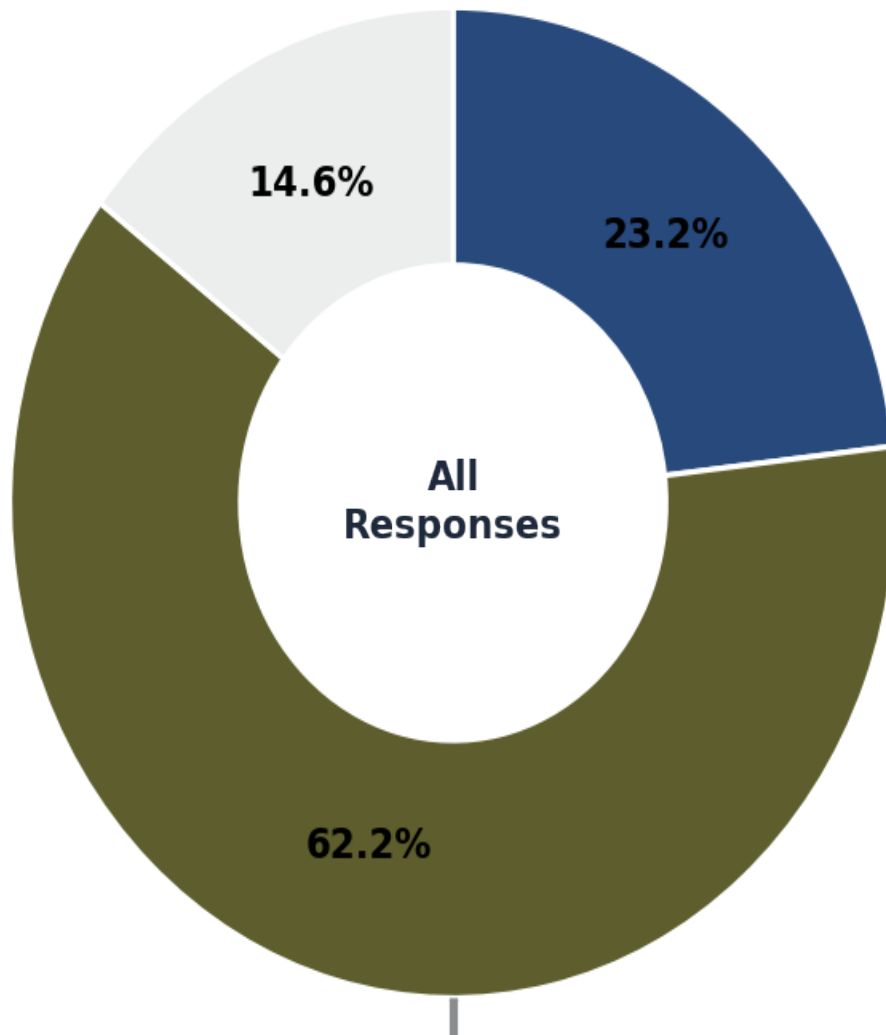

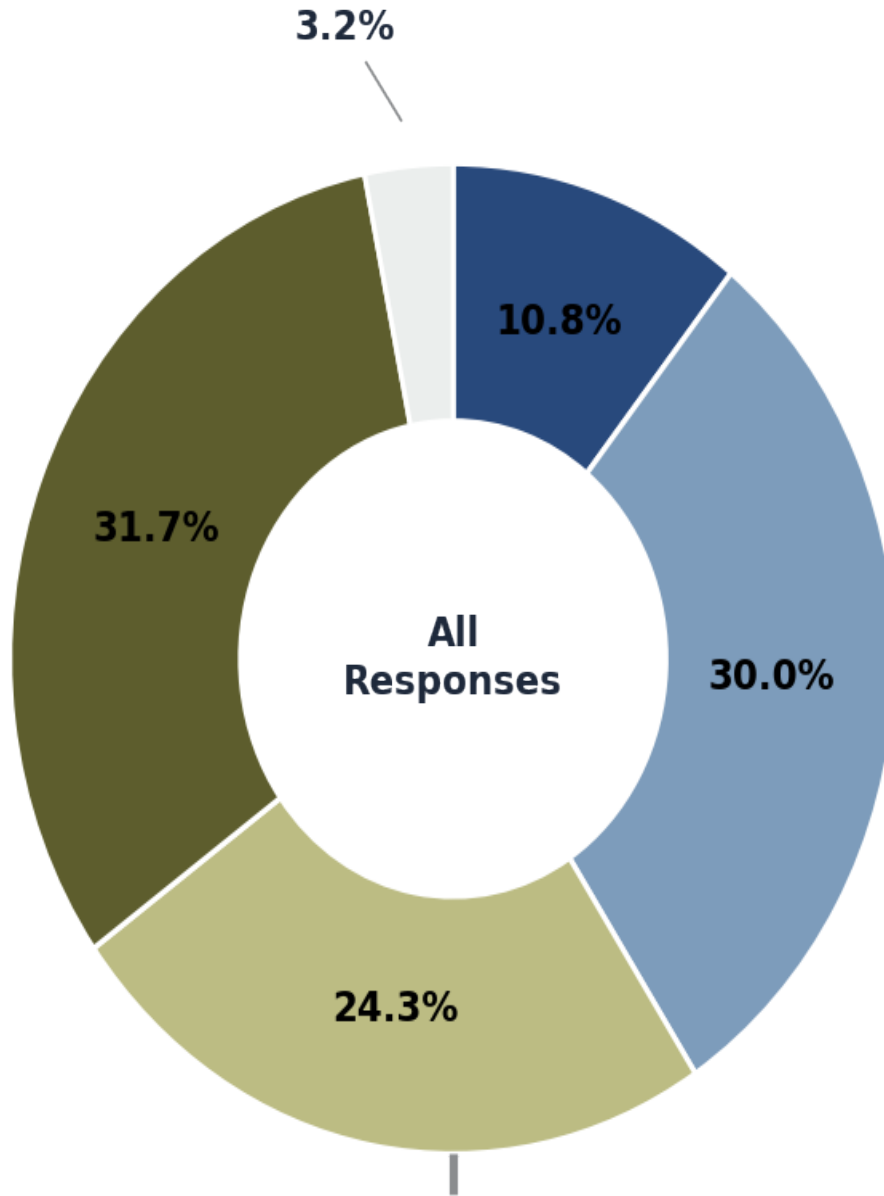

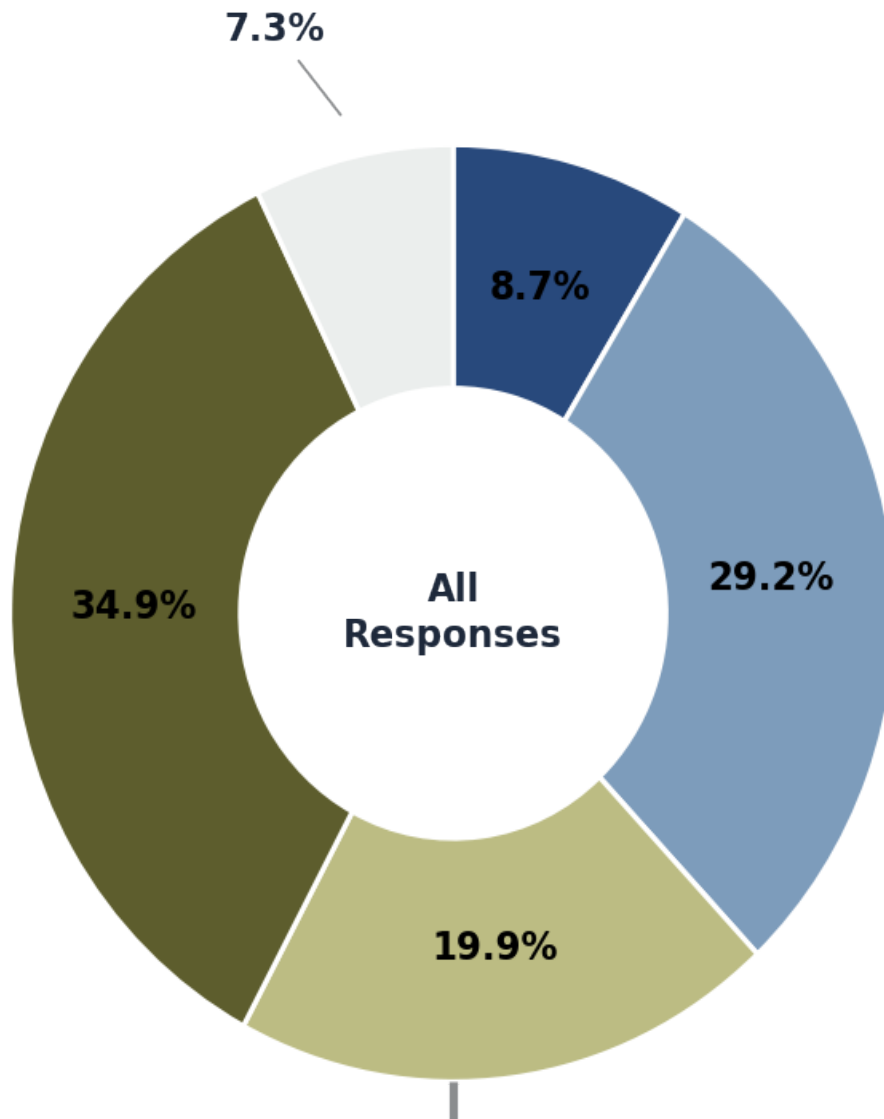

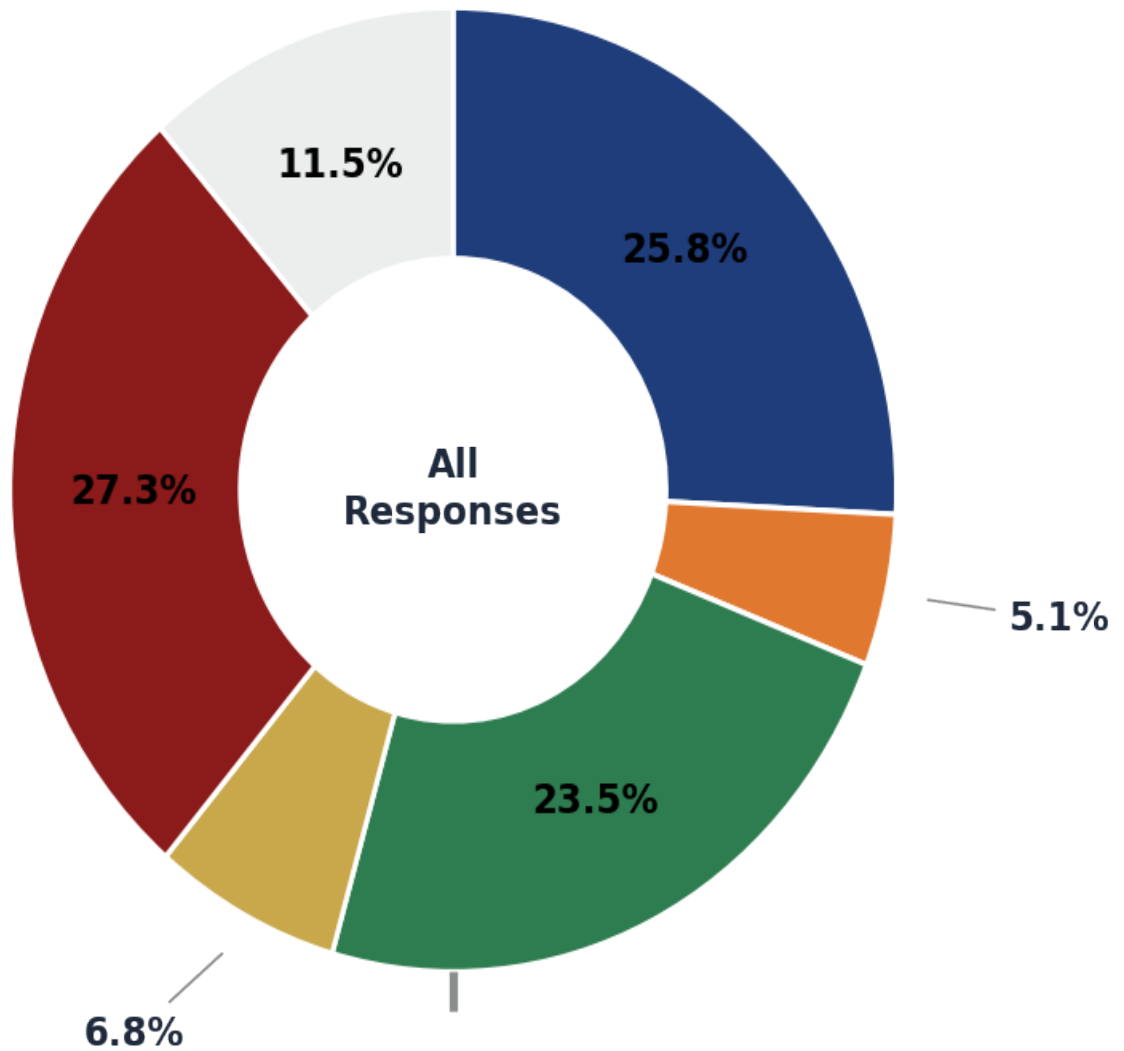
