This intensive, hands-on workshop is designed to equip you with advanced skills in triage, life support, critical emergency procedures and intensive care unit (ICU) management under the direct guidance of renowned clinical specialists.

DETAILED COURSE CURRICULUM

Module 1: Vascular Access

THEORY & LECTURE: Emergency line preparation, strict asepsis, catheter care, spotting and treating phlebitis, and safe administration protocols for drugs and fluids.

CORE SKILLS: Venous cut-down, Intraosseous (IO) access, Peripheral IV catheter maintenance.

EXTRA / ELECTIVE SKILLS: PICC line placement.

Module 2: Airway Management

THEORY & LECTURE: How to prepare for an airway emergency setting up the intubation tray, suction equipment, emergency drugs, and rapid response team readiness.

CORE SKILLS: Emergency intubation, securing difficult/obscured airways.

EXTRA / ELECTIVE SKILLS: Airway suctioning, Endotracheal wash, Tracheostomy, Cricothyroidotomy.

Module 3: Breathing & Oxygenation

THEORY & LECTURE: Respiratory distress localization and pathology identification, oxygen delivery techniques using standard clinical equipment.

CORE SKILLS: Oxygen delivery (flow-by, mask, oxygen cage), Nasal prongs & nasopharyngeal catheterization, Non-invasive ventilation (NIV), Manual positive pressure ventilation (PPV).

EXTRA / ELECTIVE SKILLS: Thoracocentesis, Pericardiocentesis, Chest tube insertion.

Module 4: Cardiac Arrest & CPR (Basic Life Support)

THEORY & LECTURE: Early recognition of cardiopulmonary arrest and team-based Basic Life Support (BLS) execution without reliance on advanced drugs.

CORE SKILLS: Arrest identification within seconds, High-quality chest compressions (depth, rate, position), Ventilation mechanics during CPR, Team dynamics & leadership, Table-based drills.

Module 5: Gastrointestinal & Enteral Feeding

THEORY & LECTURE: Calculating RER, timing enteral nutrition in critically ill patients, gastric decompression indication, and gut protection strategies.

CORE SKILLS: Nasogastric (NG) tube placement, RER calculation (volume & frequency), Tube feeding execution.

EXTRA / ELECTIVE SKILLS: Oesophagostomy (E-tube) placement, Orogastic & Percutaneous gastric decompression, Gastric lavage.

Module 6: Urinary & Excretory Care

THEORY & LECTURE: Sterile catheter maintenance, closed collection systems, catheter removal timing, and care for incontinent or obstructed patients.

CORE SKILLS: Urethral catheterization (canine & feline), Catheter hygiene & management, Fecal catheter management.

EXTRA / ELECTIVE SKILLS: Decompressivity cystocentesis, Percutaneous pigtail cystostomy.
