1. Our Online Communities

2. Our Purpose

We use these platforms to:

3. What We Welcome

- Sharing relevant articles (with proper credit)

4. What We Don't Allow

✗ Prohibited Content:

- Copyright violations – don't share content without permission
- Harassment or abuse – be kind and respectful
- Climate denial – we're science-based

- Spam or ads – no commercial promotions without permission
- Off-topic posts – keep it relevant to our mission
- Misinformation – stick to facts and evidence

5. Copyright Rules

PSC has a copyright policy. When sharing content:

- Give credit to original creators
- Link to sources instead of copying full articles
- Only share what you have permission to use
- Ask before using substantial amounts of copyrighted material

When you post on our pages:

- You keep ownership of your content
- You give us permission to share and engage with your posts
- Make sure you have the right to share anything you post

6. Privacy

- We follow our Privacy Policy across all platforms
- Member hub content stays private within the community
- Be careful what personal information you share publicly
- Each platform has its own privacy settings – we encourage you to check them before participating

7. Professional boundaries

Important:

- We don't provide individual therapy through social media or via online communities
- Our content is educational, not professional advice
