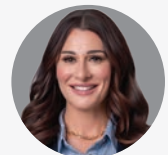

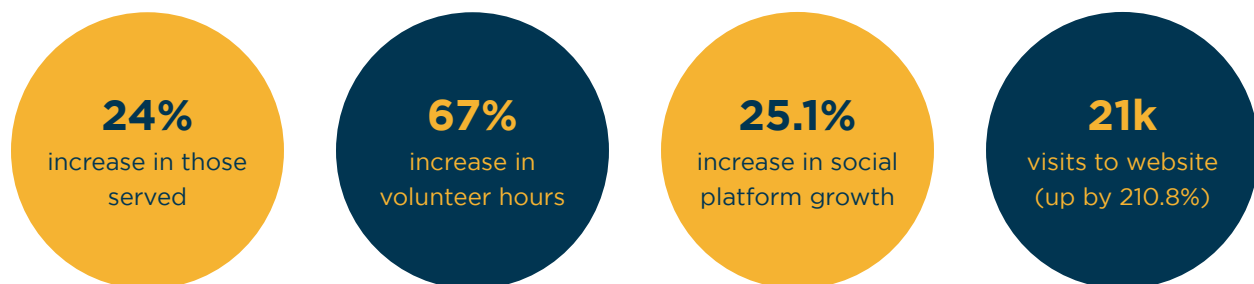
GROWTH IN 2025

Growing Our Reach. Deepening Our Impact.

At Angel Reach, we help young people ages 16 to 24 who are in crisis or at risk of homelessness by offering transitional living services. We do more than give them a safe place to stay. We offer stability, hope, guidance, and the support they need to work toward a better future.

We mainly serve the Greater Houston area, but welcome young people from anywhere. Our community understands trauma and supports each person's physical, emotional, and mental health, knowing everyone has faced different challenges. We guide these young people as they move into adulthood, helping them gain the skills, resources, and confidence they need for lasting independence and a stable future.

Meet the Community

In Texas, over 300,000 young people are at risk of homelessness. Many who turn to Angel Reach face tough challenges on their path to stability and independence. These challenges can include:

- **Not having a safe or stable place to live**
- **Dealing with substance use issues**
- **Not having a high school diploma or GED**
- **Being unemployed or not having enough work**
- **Facing mental health challenges or dealing with trauma**

At Angel Reach, we support every young person with compassion, respect, and without judgment. We offer personalized help, trauma-informed care, and real relationships to help youth overcome obstacles and reach their goals. This could mean earning a diploma, finding a job, improving mental health, or securing a permanent home. Our goal is to help them create lives filled with hope, stability, and lasting independence.

More Applications. More Youth Housed. More Hope.

Less than two years ago, the Angel Reach Village opened its doors, allowing us to help more young people facing homelessness. The Village did more than just add beds; it created a new way for youth to live more independently. As they learn important daily skills in a shared home, they can move into their own duplex. This gives them more independence while still staying connected to the support and community that Angel Reach offers.

In 2025, our housing program grew in important ways. More young people reached out for our help, and they also stayed in the program longer. Instead of just using our services for quick housing or short-term needs, youth are choosing to stay, focus on their personal growth, and reach important goals before moving on to independence.

At Angel Reach, we know that real success takes time. As we often say, ***“The longer you stay, the greater your opportunity for success.”*** Our program is built to give young people the time, resources, and relationships they need to reach their goals, instead of pushing them through quickly. We support each youth from crisis to confidence, making sure they have what they need to finish strong and build a future filled with hope, stability, and independence. When we invest in young people, we make our whole community stronger.

Fueling Futures, One Meal at a Time

At Angel Reach, making sure young people have healthy meals and groceries is one of our main goals. Many of the youth we help have faced food insecurity and have not had many chances to learn how to cook or eat regular, nutritious meals.

Thanks to our partnerships with the Montgomery County Food Bank and Keep Us Fed, Angel Reach gives out weekly food boxes to youth and kinship families. This helps make sure they always have the food they need. Our Resource Kitchen also cooks and serves hot, healthy meals during the week, offering a place where young people can eat together and connect with others.

When young people have their basic needs met, they can focus on their goals, follow their dreams, and work toward a stable, independent future.

Removing Barriers, One Ride at a Time

Reliable transportation helps youth get to school, work, medical appointments, and community events. As Angel Reach has grown, so has the need for dependable rides. In 2025, with more youth joining our programs, we saw more requests for transportation to help them stay connected to the resources and opportunities they need to succeed.

Thanks to the generous support of **Montgomery County Community Development** and **Sparky and Debbie Gullo**, Angel Reach met these needs and replaced old, high-mileage vehicles with two new cars and a transport van. These new vehicles not only lower maintenance and repair costs, but also give youth safe, reliable rides to classes, jobs, healthcare, and community activities.

These vehicles do more than provide rides. They help youth connect with one another, join in community activities, and feel the support and stability of the Angel Reach community wherever they go.

Caring for the Whole Person

Angel Reach's program gives each youth the resources, support, and opportunities they need to build a successful future. With the help of our community partners, in 2025 we expanded access to psychiatric and medical services, so more youth received care and support tailored to their needs.

We use trauma-informed care in all our programs, creating strategies that recognize each youth's unique experiences, challenges, and strengths. This helps us meet immediate needs and build a strong foundation for long-term stability, resilience, and success in the community.

We are committed to more than just housing and emotional support. In 2025, more youth received essential medical, dental, and vision care. By providing glasses, treating medical and dental issues, and connecting youth to ongoing healthcare, we help them feel better, restore their dignity, and support their long-term health.

Creating Pathways to Success

At Angel Reach, we believe education is key to stability, independence, and long-term economic success. More than 70 percent of the young people who join our programs have not finished high school, so helping them achieve this goal is a top priority. We work with each youth to earn a high school diploma or GED and reach this important milestone.

Our Foster Success program is growing and gives young people the resources and encouragement they need to reach their educational goals. Education staff are on-site, offering one-on-one support, including tutoring, campus visits, help with online courses, working with local schools, and completing applications.

By removing barriers and providing steady support, Angel Reach helps young people gain the tools, confidence, and opportunities they need to succeed in school and build a strong foundation for lifelong independence.

Creating Opportunities for Independence

Many of the young people we work with have little experience in the workplace or know what it takes to get and keep a job. Angel Reach's employment program helps close this gap by offering guidance, coaching, and practical tools for lasting career success.

Through the **Foster Success** program, clients set their job goals and get one-on-one support to build the skills they need for meaningful work. We help with workplace expectations, job readiness, applications, interviews, and the skills needed to succeed on the job.

In 2025, Angel Reach formed a partnership with **Memorial Hermann The Woodlands**, opening new doors for young people to start careers in healthcare. Their entry-level **Patient Care Technician** program gives our clients paid clinical jobs, along with full training, onboarding, and mentorship.

Thanks to strong community support and personalized help, Angel Reach's employment program has helped **73 percent** of our housed clients find work. These partnerships offer more than just jobs. They open doors to career growth, financial stability, and independence.

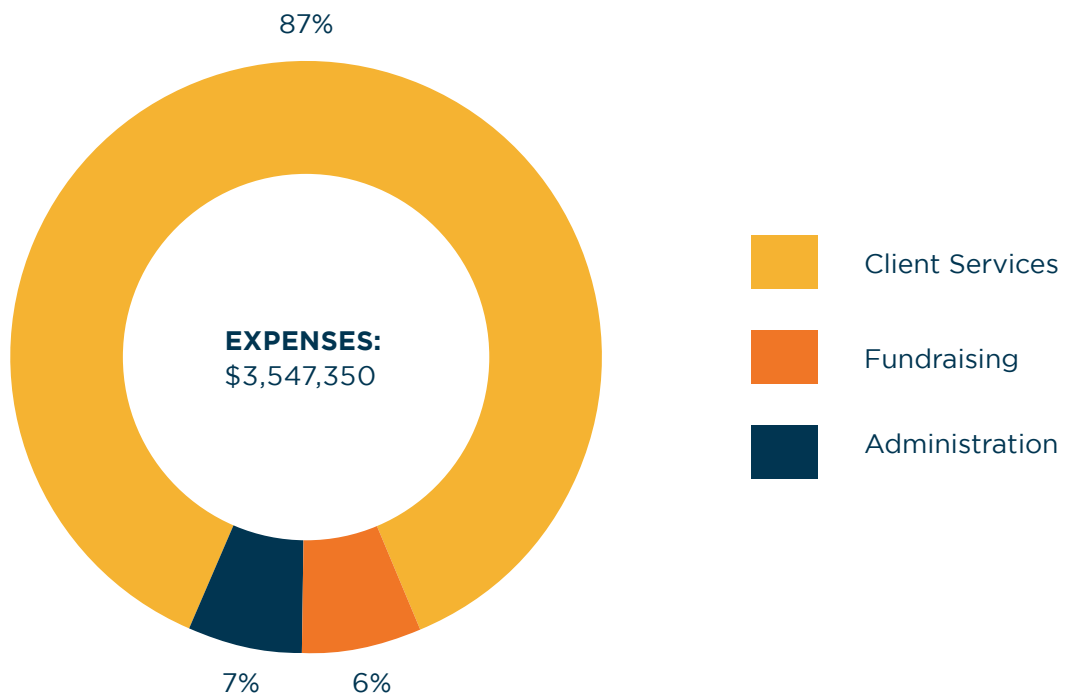
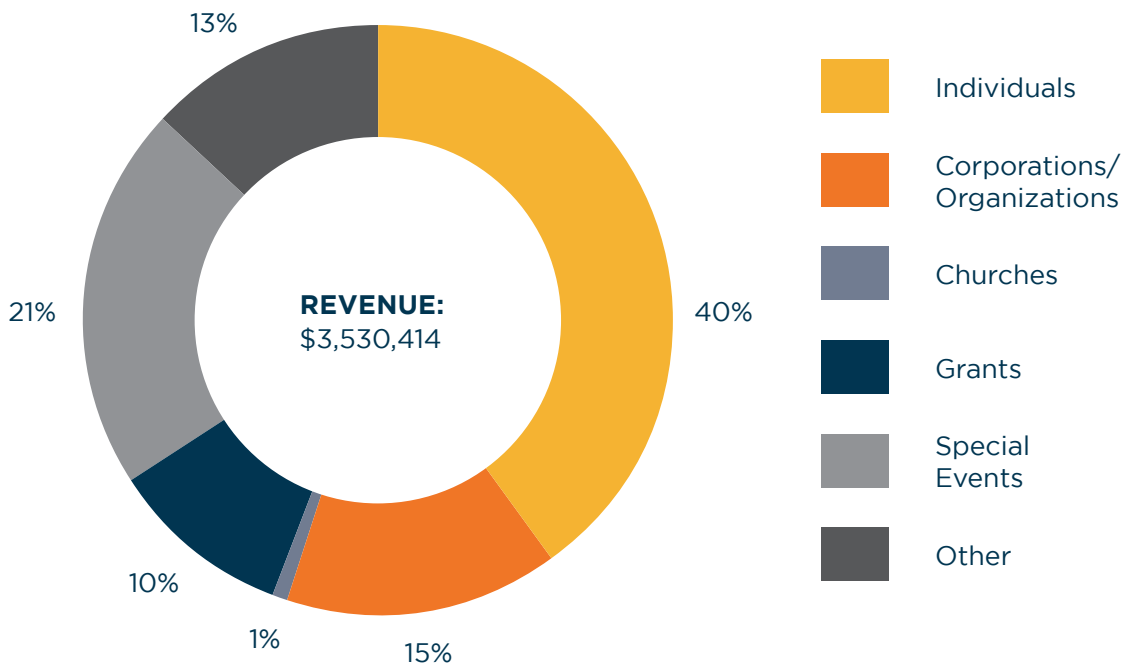
