Unlike traditional wound cleansers that provide only irrigation, ViaCLYR combines mechanical wound cleansing with controlled antimicrobial activity that persist for up to 72 hours under repeated microbial challenge in controlled lab testing.

The result is an advanced wound management platform designed to support care from the battlefield to the operating room, through hospitalizations, rehabilitation, and recovery.



WHY VIACLYR MATTERS

Military medicine faces a persistent challenge regardless of the theater of operation: **The longer the time between injury and definitive care, the greater the challenge of preserving tissue and controlling infection and downstream complications.**
