BUS TRANSPORTATION AGREEMENT

The purpose of this Agreement is to set forth The John Carroll School's expectations when a student rides the bus.

TERM AND LEVEL OF SERVICE

- The term of this Agreement is a full academic year.
- Riders may register for Round-Trip, One-Way (AM), or One-Way (PM) service.

FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

- The total cost of transportation will be shared by all riders' parents/guardians and billed to the Student Account.
- Parents/guardians signing this Agreement understand that they are obligated to make their payments regardless of how many days, weeks, or months their student(s) ride the bus.
- Each parent/guardian will fulfill his/her financial obligation to the School. Failure of the parent/guardian to satisfy the obligation as specified in this Agreement may result in denial of the student's attendance, examinations, or diploma.

CANCELLATION

- The last day that this Agreement may be terminated without liability for transportation charges is the first day of the academic year.
- Late cancellation requests will be honored only if the student's seat can be filled with another rider.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The John Carroll School is responsible for meeting the safety standards specified by the Maryland State Motor Vehicle Administration Rules and Regulations Governing the Transportation of School Children (11.02.06) as amended.
- The John Carroll School will create bus routes and establish times of boarding and departure. Routes and times are subject to change based on safety and traffic patterns.
- Students are expected to ride their assigned bus.
- Behavior on the bus is to be consistent with *The John Carroll Student Handbook*. The School reserves the right to enforce the policies of the *Student Handbook*.
- Parents/guardians agree to make full restitution for acts of vandalism by a student.
- The School reserves the right to cancel this Agreement if the student engages in activity that impedes the safety of the bus, driver, or other students.
- Parents/guardians are to direct concerns and/or complaints to <u>The John Carroll School</u>
 <u>Transportation Department</u>, which will work with the parent/guardian and student to resolve
 the matter.
