

John Carroll Math Students!

The Math Department at John Carroll has decided to give ALL students a summer assignment for their course for next year. The summer assignment is intended to help you review topics that you will need to recall or use in your next course in the fall. The required assignment must be completed for the course you will be taking next year – 2026-27 school year. You can find that information in Veracross for your classes. The assignment is on Delta Math – this is an online adaptive program that will provide you different questions based on how you did the previous one. For each course, there are a variety of skills to complete and for each skill you will be required to compete **5 QUESTIONS CORRECTLY**. If it is a skill you are struggling with, it might take you more than 5 questions and that is fine, you need to have 5 correct in each section. You will need to monitor this because it will not automatically stop you in a particular section. In addition, there are hints for problems and if you get a question incorrect, it will give you a detailed explanation on how to solve it and where you went wrong. This is a great tool, and we encourage you to use it.

The assignment is due by the first day of school for all students, so the due date is **THURSDAY September 3rd 2026**. If any assignments are turned in late, you could be subject to a loss of points and any assignments not turned in will be given a 0. In addition to the assignment, all courses will have some type of “assessment” or “quiz” within the first cycle of classes to check for understanding of the summer topics and provide teachers with feedback on those topics. There is no additional work that needs to be submitted for the summer assignment other than Delta Math.

Below is the directions for accessing the summer assignment. There is also a video posted that will show you how to access the assignment as well.

STUDENS WITHOUT A DELTAMATH ACCOUNT


























































If you do not have an account with delta math you will need to create one and then you can access the assignment.

- 1) Use the site www.deltamath.com to access the material
- 2) On the main page select “**For Students**”
- 3) Select **Register**
- 4) You will be prompted to select a course code – **enter 298191**
- 5) You will then select the course you are going into next school year. (if you are taking multiple courses – select 1 course and then follow the directions below to add another)
- 6) At this point you will need to create an account – you will need an email address and password. Please use something you can remember because the teacher will not have access to change it.
- 7) Once you are registered, you will be taken back to the home screen and you will be able to log-in and can start the assignment.

STUDENTS WITH A DELTA MATH ACCOUNT

If you already have an account with delta math, you do not need to create a new one, you will just enroll in the new “class

- 1) Use the site www.deltamath.com to access the material
- 2) On the main page login with your email and password
- 3) On the left hand side, there is a prompt that says “**Add New Class**”. Enter the correct 8 digit code from the list below. You will only register for 1 course unless you are taking multiple, then register for all your courses.
- 4) Once you are in the new class, you will see the summer assignment and start.
