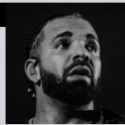

**CORAN CAPSHAW**

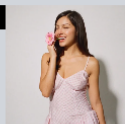

**THEO SEDLMAYR**

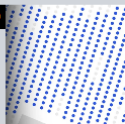
