ABSTRACT

An abstract is a single paragraph, without subheadings, indentation or references. It should be an explicit summary of your presentation that states 1) the problem, 2) the objectives, 3) the methods used, and 4) the major results and conclusions. It should be 1.15-spaced in 11-point Times New Roman. Do not include bullets/lists or references in the abstract. Use only SI units. Use a zero before decimal points such as “0.45,” not “.45.” The first part of your abstract should state the problem or issue you set out to solve and explain your rationale for pursuing the research. The purpose of your study is to solve this problem and/or add to your discipline’s understanding of the issue. Your abstract should also describe the methods. Furthermore, your abstract should indicate the results or outcomes of the work you have done so far. Finally, your abstract should close with a statement of the project’s implications and contributions to its field. The content of the abstract will be the basis for acceptance for an oral or poster presentation at the Biochar Summit 2026. Authors will be informed about acceptance for presentation via email. Be sure to adhere to the word limitation for the abstract (200 - 400 words). The abstract should be submitted in the format of MS Word (.doc or .docx) document or as a pdf file.

Keywords: single, paragraph, summarizes, words indentation (maximum 6 words)

Themes: 1-2 most relevant themes from the conference sessions. Visit the website and refer the conference sessions indicated

Images:

- A maximum of 3 images/figures/ charts can be included per abstract.
- Place the images in the same MS Word document after the selected themes.
- Provide a 1-2-line caption below the figures, describing the content.

Biography

Please send the biography of the presenter together with the abstract using the following format:

1. Full name
2. Position/department/organization/ company/ country
3. Short biography (word count should not exceed 50 words)
4. Contact information (address, contact/mobile number, email address, optional: LinkedIn account)
