

Biochar Summit Terms & Conditions

1.0 Supplementary participation and cancellation policy for attendees

Unless stated otherwise, the contracting party for customers purchasing tickets for in-person events is the European Biochar Industry Consortium e.V (BCE), Augustinerplatz 2, 79098 Freiburg im Breisgau, Germany. Once we have received your registration & payment, we will send you an email with your registration documents.

1.1 Purchase & payment for attendees

The purchase of admission tickets must be purchased through the online registration system on the Biochar Summit website: www.biochar-summit.eu. Payment is due via the options available through the online registration system. Registrants will receive confirmation of their registration as well as your ticket via our online registration system.

1.2 Cancellation

If the attendee cancels the registration up to 30 calendar days before the start of the event, we will not charge a cancellation fee. Return transfers of attendance fees that have already been paid are subject to a processing fee of €50 plus VAT. In the event of cancellation between 30 and 15 calendar days prior to the start of the event, we will charge a processing fee of €120 plus VAT. If attendees withdraw 14 calendar days or less prior to the start of the event, or in the event of nonattendance without withdrawal, the full attendance fee will be charged, unless evidence of a different amount of damages or expenses is provided. All cancellations must be made in writing. Admission to the event may be transferred to a substitute attendee at any time before the start of the event.

1.3 Liability

BCE shall only be liable for any property damage or financial loss for which BCE is responsible – regardless of the legal reason – in the case of intent or gross negligence. Place of performance and jurisdiction is Freiburg im Breisgau, Germany.

1.4 Still photos, videos and sound recordings

Please note that still photos, videos and/or sound will be recorded during the event, which may be published for the purposes of reporting, general public relations and advertising. If you do not consent to the creation and use of such recordings, please indicate this clearly.

Press photographers must obtain permission from the organizers. Photographs and sound recordings not intended for private use are prohibited; exceptions require the written permission of the conference host.

BCE reserves the copyrights and all other rights to conference content, website content, databases and trademarks. The user is not allowed to copy content or make it available to third parties via the internet contrary to applicable copyright regulations.

1.5 Prohibition of disclosure of personal attendee access data / account blocking in the event of multiple use or copyright infringement

The access data that you have received for download areas and similar internal areas of an event of BCE's are personalized, exclusively reserved for direct customers of the BCE and non-transferrable.

2.0 Supplementary participation and cancellation policy for poster presenters & speakers

The conference advisory / reviewing committee will evaluate the submitted abstracts and compile a program of lectures and scientific posters from the accepted proposals as well as additional invitations.

All accepted submissions will be published with equal coverage in the (digital) conference documentation / proceedings.

The conference advisory / reviewing committee reserves the right to accept or reject submissions for lectures or posters. Cancellations shall only be admissible for important reasons. If speakers and poster supervisors of the submissions accepted by the conference advisory committee (one person per accepted submission) are automatically registered as conference attendees, they shall receive an invoice for the discounted attendance fee from BCE. The complete General Terms and Conditions may already have been included in the call for papers and actively accepted when the submission was uploaded.

Any other agreements for speakers are subject to a separate speaker agreement.

Place of performance and jurisdiction is Freiburg im Breisgau, Germany.

Complete submissions must be uploaded to the conference website by the deadline set and clearly communicated by the organizers and in accordance with the given requirements. Acceptance of the abstract does not guarantee acceptance of the paper for the conference literature / proceedings. All submissions must comply with the guidelines provided by the conference literature publisher and will be subject to a separate scientific review process. This review process includes the possibility of the paper being returned to the authors with a request for corrections/changes or being rejected. Such corrections/changes shall be returned by the deadline provided, otherwise the paper will be rejected. Further information on the review criteria can be found on the conference website.

3.0 Supplementary participation and cancellation policy for exhibitors

Upon receipt of your registration as an exhibitor at BCE events, you will receive a confirmation of registration and an invoice. Unless otherwise agreed, the exhibition fee shall be due for payment without deduction upon receipt of the invoice. Participation as an exhibitor at BCE's events will not be permitted until the exhibition fee has been paid. Any exhibition fee payments made are non-refundable. Costs incurred from non-attendance, premature termination of the exhibition or participation in the event or problems accessing the conference platform shall not be refunded.

Termination of this agreement for any reason shall not affect any accrued rights or claims of either party to this agreement against the other.

A substitute exhibitor may only participate with BCE's expressed permission.

If the conference cannot take place or is postponed due to events beyond the BCE's control (force majeure), if the conference is canceled by the organizer or if the online platform becomes inaccessible, the BCE may, at its sole discretion, determine and reimburse to the exhibitors the pro rata amount of the exhibition fees received that remains after deducting the costs incurred. In no event shall the amount of reimbursement to the exhibitor exceed the amount of the fee paid.
