Payment and Cancellation Policies

The full tour fee is due upon arrival at the Museum. Payments are accepted by Check, Credit Card, or Cash. We do not accept Purchase Orders.

Reservation changes (Including cancellations, reschedules, or changes to the number of participants or tour groups) are only acceptable via email. Reservation changes via phone will not be accepted and will result in the associated penalty fees (see below for more details).

Cancellations and/or changes to the group tour reservation that occur within one week will be assessed a \$50 penalty fee per tour group.

No-shows and/or day-of cancellations will be assessed a cancellation fee of \$275 per scheduled tour group.

Without prior notification of any changes, the original total will be expected upon arrival, regardless of final attendance.

No additional adults are permitted beyond the amount specified.

All chaperones must stay with their tour groups at all times and must follow the tour itinerary as led by their appointed Museum Tour Guide(s).
