

Content of our Tour Guide Training





Theoretical training

We meet for two days in our 4* partner hotel **Radisson Hotel and Conference Centre London Heathrow**. Our theoretical training is aimed at all new, inexperienced tour guides, or at those who are tour guides but have not accompanied IKTS tours, yet. It is based on the **EU-certified EN-15565** local tour guide training and includes exciting topics such as presentation techniques, dealing with groups, local customs, role-playing, phonetics and much more.

Practical training

Now is the time to put our training into practice, given all the knowledge we have. At the same time, it's time to say goodbye to our "Scottish" participants, who will be making their way to Edinburgh on the third day. The "English" will head straight to the airport transfer training in the morning.

England training

After breakfast, we head straight to the airport as the saying goes: "First impressions count!" We intensively prepare you for the first encounter with your guests: the **airport transfer**. We teach you all the tricks on site, so that you shine with expert knowledge on your first transfer.

Afterwards we drive to **London** on our coach. Before you board, our experienced guide shows you how to greet and communicate with the **coach driver**, because you are one team on tour. Our guide shows you the sights and explains the route and other insider knowledge on a panoramic tour. We are leaving the coach at Westminster Pier for a **boat trip on the Thames**. Exciting: Our first entrance! You learn how and where to redeem our customer's vouchers and how to proceed to the pier.

The following day we leave London behind and head South-West via **Windsor, Stonehenge and Salisbury** to our hotel for the next few nights. The next days we will explore **Cornwall** as we visit **St. Ives, St. Michael's Mount** and try **Cornish tea at Land's End**.

There is so much to experience and, above all, to learn. You will be prepared for **each city tour** and will experience the trip just like your guests will - the only difference is you will be sitting up front to **present a topic and be in charge for a while every day**.





Scotland training

In the morning we take the train to **Edinburgh** and finish our journey at the airport. Because we know: First impressions are always the most important. We intensively train you for the first encounter with your guests: the **airport transfer**. We teach you all the tricks on site, so that you shine with expert knowledge on your first transfer.

The next day we explore Edinburgh and **Glasgow**. Our experienced guide shows you how to greet and communicate with the **coach driver**: you're buddies on tour. Our experienced guide explains the sights and the respective city tours.

The next day we drive to our first entrance venue: **St Andrews Whisky Distillery**. You learn how and where to redeem our customer's vouchers and how to proceed with the group.

In addition to all the **magical castles**, we also visit **Stirling**, **Inverness**, **Aberdeen** and in **Pitlochry** we try the **traditional shortbread**. Absolute highlight? **The Scottish Highlands**. With its Folk Museum, Dornoch and of course the **boat trip on Loch Lomond** or Loch Ness. This is part of nearly every tour and therefore also part of our training.

You will experience it just like your guests later - only that you will also hold the microphone at the front of the bus for the **presentation of a topic** you prepared beforehand. In addition you'll **be in charge for a while every day**.
