


## Child Screening Services

As part of Goodwill Easterseals Miami Valley children's services, free developmental screenings are offered to provide a quick and simple way to monitor the healthy development of children. A developmental screening tool is often the first step toward recognizing potential concerns. Early detection of a developmental delay can often lead to a better prognosis for the child.

At no cost to you, Goodwill Easterseals Miami Valley will provide an annual, center-wide screening within your home-based or center-based child care program. Pending parental permission, a trained child outreach specialist will conduct on-site screenings using a developmental screening tool for children from birth to five years old.

### Resources To Achieve Independence

- **Follow-up** - In the event of a suspected delay, our child outreach specialist will work with the center director and the family to assist with follow-up for further evaluation through appropriate community agencies and the child's pediatrician. Families have an option to accept or decline further evaluation.
- **Re-screens** - In the event of a mild concern, stranger anxiety, or lack of follow-up with a recommended referral, the child outreach specialist may schedule a time to re-screen specific children. Our program strives to provide supportive monitoring of children who might benefit from early intervention.
- **Second Opinions** - Addressing concerns with a family about their child's development is never easy. For centers that currently offer a formal developmental screen, a child outreach specialist can assist you by conducting an additional screening and observation of a child who may have developmental concerns. As needed, the specialist will work with you to assist a family with follow-up for formal evaluation.
- **Services** - Provided in Clark, Darke, Preble, Greene, Miami, Montgomery and Warren Counties.




**Your family is eligible for this FREE program if:**

### About Recovery & Employment

The Recovery and Employment program aims to help individuals secure long-term employment. Our Employment Specialist will meet with you to understand your needs and goals and assist in finding a job that aligns with those goals. We will provide guidance during the job search and after employment to support your growth and job retention. We want to support you as you work towards a better life for you and your family.

### Eligibility Requirements

This program is available to individuals in the recovery process or individuals who have used illegal substances, used alcohol to excess or have used a prescription drug not as prescribed.

### We can assist with the following:

- Resume development
- Personalized job search with an Employment Specialist
- Connecting with employers in the community
- Finding job opportunities not advertised
- Exploring a variety of jobs and opportunities
- Job interview preparation
- Industry recognized certifications
- Linkage to Peer Support if needed to help in the recovery process
- Connecting you to community resources
- Job retention supports with focus on life stability, job advancement and long-term retention
- Temporary assistance with transportation for job interviews and new employment\*
- Assistance with getting required work attire before starting new job\*
