Florida Judge Rules Amendment 3 Ballot Language "Defective"

A Florida circuit judge ruled Monday that the ballot language for the Legislature's property tax amendment (Amendment 3) is "defective." The amendment is still on track to appear on the November ballot, but Attorney General James Uthmeier has ten days to rewrite the title and summary.

Note: *To pass, Amendment 3 must receive 60% of the vote on the November 3 ballot.*
