1. Proud in the Cloud Event at The Ranch

- Focus: Concerns about event planning and staffing
- Council Vote: Approved hiring 10 additional staff (at no cost to the organization)
 - Vote: 4-1 (Council Member Shawn Fletcher opposed)
- Recommendation: Future events should have more staff to fit expected attendance
- 2. Toho Water Billing Proposed Change to Tax Billing Process
 - Highlights of Proposed Change:
 - Guaranteed collection
 - Majority of revenue collected in Q1
 - May reduce billing costs for special collection and commercial properties
 - Eliminates Toho's annual billing cost of \$378,000
 - Challenges:
 - Requires adoption at public hearing by Jan 1, 2026
 - Will require extensive public education campaign
 - Possible early payment revenue loss
 - Delayed billing timeline
 - Cost to create a tax file for approx. 33,000 parcels
 - Outcome: No decision made; staff will return with two options for consideration
- 3. Budget Update
 - Next Workshop: July 14, 2025 at 1:00 PM in the St. Cloud Council Chambers
 - Topic: City Budget Discussion
- 4. Grant Program Updates
 - Focus: Community support through nonprofits
 - Changes Established based on council recommendations:
 - Eligibility process to increase transparency and partnerships
 - Establish an Advisory Committee for selection and evaluation

- Review the value of special events through the advisory committee
- Additional Proposal (Mayor):
 - Cancel the current 3-year, \$50,000 consultant program for capacity building
 - City Attorney to review; will be discussed in the next meeting
- 5. St. Cloud Chamber of Commerce Discussion
 - Chamber Request: \$15,000 for standard trustee membership
 - Council Discussion:
 - Request will appear on a future agenda
 - City and Chamber participation in major events like the Christmas Parade) will not be affected
 - Jennifer Paul to meet with the Chamber to review events and numbers before final action
 - Related Item:
 - Main Street Agreement to follow a similar review process; will return for a final decision
