Public Hearing - Resolution approving a temporary suspension of Kissimmee Code, Chapter 30 – Personnel, Article II – Code of Ethics, Sec. 30-25 - **Approved 3-2.**
Commissioner Angela Eady & Janette Martinez voted against.

This resolution looks to approve a temporary stay to allow the City Attorney's office the opportunity to draft revisions to this section of the city code, bringing it into alignment with state statutes so that future complaints received make sense under the Commission on Ethics and state law. To be clear, the intent of this is not to undo any actions this Commission has already taken. This stay will apply strictly to new complaints, not existing ones.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

8.A Blue Line Solutions Appeal of City Manager's Decision Upholding the Cancellation of RFP2026001, School Speed Detection Cameras. **Approved 5-0**

The City recently issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for the installation of school zone speed detection cameras across several local school zones. Following formal challenges from multiple vendors, the Procurement Officer made the administrative decision to cancel the RFP. While Blue Line has filed an appeal regarding this decision, explicit City procurement policy grants the City the absolute right to cancel an RFP and reject all bids at any time without providing justification. In tandem with



the procurement challenges, there are ongoing concerns regarding the legal landscape of automated camera enforcement. The Circuit Court is currently reviewing the constitutionality of red-light cameras. Because red-light cameras and school zone speed cameras fall under the exact same statutory framework, any ruling on the constitutionality of one directly impacts the other. Due to the combination of the pending procurement appeal and the current legal uncertainty in the courts, the City will take no further action on this project at this time.

8.B Appeal of the Development Review Committee (DRC) Decision to Renew a Conditional Use Special Event Permit Approval for Food Trucks at 1985 S. John Young Parkway. **Failed Vote 2-2 Commissioner Alvarez & Eady voted against. Commissioner Martinez did not vote.**

8.C Commission Action on Sworn Complaint Against Commissioner Janette Martinez **Failed Vote 2-2 Commissioner Ortiz & Mayor Espinoza voted against.** This means that this new complaint will not be sent to the code of ethics now and will have to wait at least six months for the new revisions to be approved.

8.D Commission Action on Sworn Complaint Against Mayor Jackie Espinosa **Failed Vote 2-2 Commissioner Ortiz & Carlos Alvarez voted against.**

8.E City Attorney Employment Agreement. **Approved 5-0**

There was concern with her salary that's \$248,000. The vice mayor is asking to lower it to \$12,000 and receiving a 30 day notice if she were to get terminated is not consistent with the previous 5 day termination notice. After much discussion it was approved as is.
