Whānau Care Service is working with Oranga Tamariki to reconnect and reintegrate mokopuna in Oranga Tamariki care and custody, with their Ngāti Porou whānau and hapū

We ensure that the goals and aspirations of mokopuna and their whānau are at the center of our support

Whānau Care will offer mokopuna and whānau the following Kaitieki Mokopuna (Caregiver) service options:

- Current Oranga Tamariki caregivers may transfer with mokopuna to our whānau care service
- New caregivers will be recruited to provide overnight, short-term, or permanent care

The key kawa and tikanga (principles and practices) of the Whānau Care Service are:

Tika, Pono, Aroha

Doing the right things, in the right way with integrity

Mātauranga

Ngāti Porou matauranga, reo, and tikanga guiding all that we do

Kaitiakitanga

Honour the legacy of our tipuna, ensuring whānau, hapū, and iwi ways of caring for our people, environments, and kaupapa, are realised

Whanaungatanga

Building and maintaining respectful and strong relationships that support the goals and needs of mokopuna and their whānau

Whakapapa

Maintaining our identity as Ngāti Porou and valuing whakapapa connections by affirming
Te mana o te tamaiti me ōna kāwai katoa, nā ōna mātua tīpuna

To ensure the success of the mokopuna care plan, all Kaitieki Mokopuna will be fully prepared with the right information at the right time, appropriate training, and ongoing support
