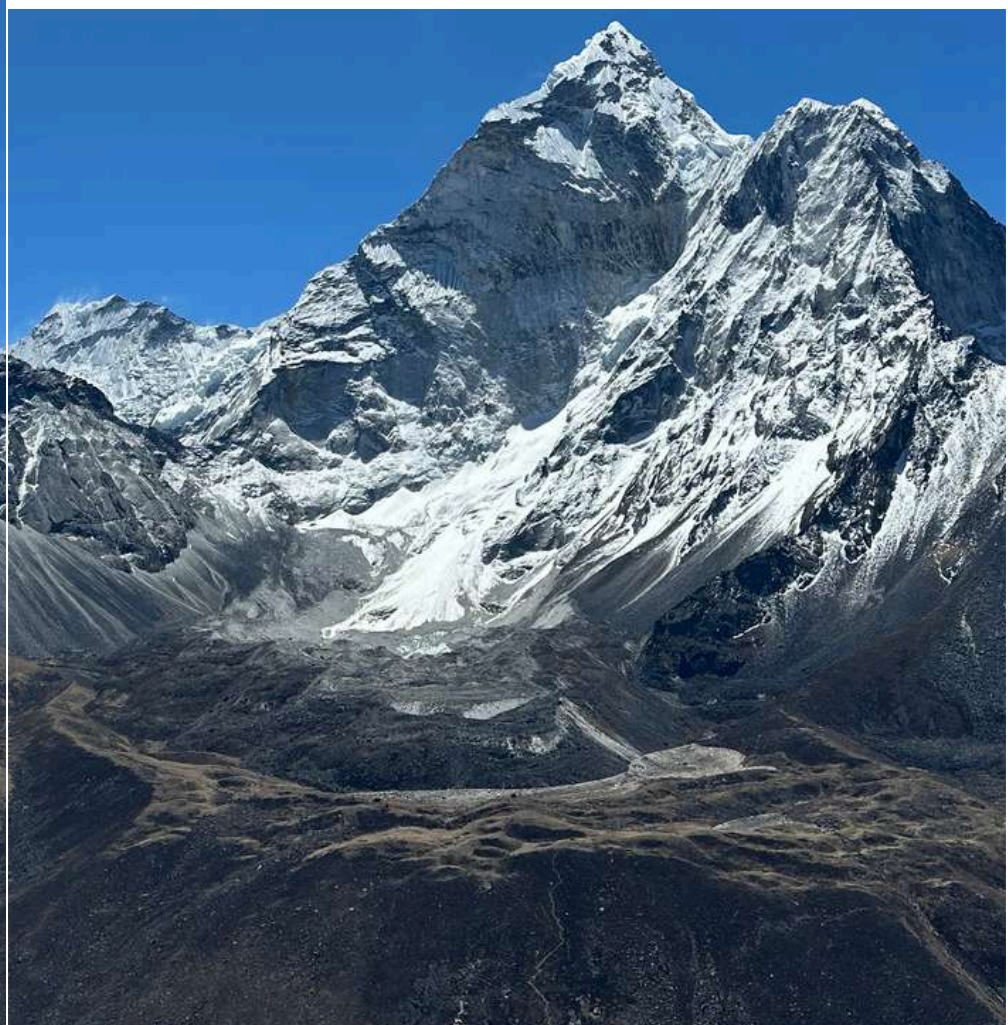

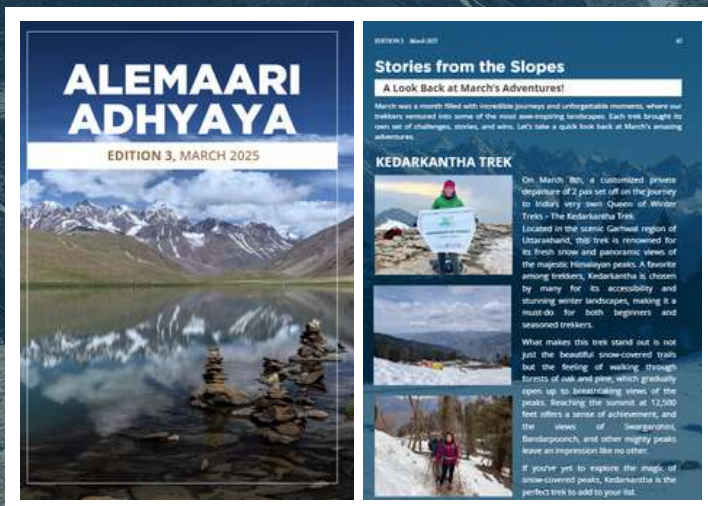

Echoes from the Himalayas

Stories That Rose in April

April brought with it a quieter charm and raw mountain beauty, as our trekkers explored some of the most striking trails of the season. Let's take a look back at the inspiring adventures that unfolded this April.

EVEREST BASE CAMP [PREMIUM] TREK

5TH APRIL 2025



On 5th April, we set out with a spirited group of nine trekkers—eight from Mumbai and one from Hyderabad. This wasn't just any team; they were doctors, marathoners, and resilient souls ready for the challenge of Everest.

The infamous Ramechhap–Lukla stretch tested their patience, as nature grounded their plans temporarily. But giving up was never an option. Instead of turning back, they turned course—literally—and took on the rugged road route to reach the trailhead.

From crossing suspension bridges to walking beside prayer-flag-lined ridgelines, they created stories to tell in their lifetime.

We stayed closely connected through every leg of the journey—realigning plans, arranging backup logistics, and sharing in their high-altitude milestones. What we carry with us are their joyful calls from the mountains, filled with gratitude and that unshakable spirit of adventure.



EVEREST BASE CAMP, GOKYO RI AND CHOLA PASS [PREMIUM] 12TH APRIL 2025



Group of **two life-saving surgeons from JIPMER, Pondicherry**, took on a different kind of life challenge this April—scaling Everest Base Camp via the awe-inspiring Gokyo Ri and Chola Pass route, and that too in reverse. Months of meticulous planning went into this expedition. For them, the mountain was a long-standing promise to themselves.

Their route began at the quieter, high-altitude lakes of Gokyo Ri, shimmering in turquoise even as the world below was warming into summer. While most trekkers save Gokyo Ri for an add-on, these doctors made it their entry point. What followed was a technically challenging yet spiritually rewarding journey through Cho La Pass and onward to the EBC trail.

EVEREST BASE CAMP [PREMIUM] TREK

12TH APRIL 2025



A family scattered across continents reunited this April but in the high Himalayas. **Three members flew in from the USA and Ivory Coast, while two joined in from India.** Connected through family, they chose Everest Base Camp as their meeting ground.

Partnered with **IIM Bangalore's adventure club Anveshan**, this journey marked a symbolic graduation trip for some, and a milestone for all. With flags from four different nations flying proudly at the EBC rock, this group turned the trail into a canvas of global unity. Every campsite became a reunion, every pass crossed became a collective win.

HAR KI DUN TREK CUSTOMISED GROUP 19TH APRIL 2025



Four people. One quiet valley. And stories that only the mountains were meant to hear.

This private group brought together two well-known Mumbai-based lawyers, a childhood friend flying in from the USA, and one of our own repeat trekkers who had walked with us to Valley of Flowers. All four came seeking the same thing—solitude.

Har Ki Dun, the cradle-shaped valley dedicated to Lord Shiva, welcomed them with alpine meadows, glacial streams, and snow-kissed views of Swargarohini and Black Peak. Their trail stayed untouched by crowds, keeping the itinerary flexible, intimate, and peaceful. Sometimes, the best conversations happen when nothing is said at all and this group knew that better than most.

ANNAPURNA CIRCUIT WITH TILICHO LAKE [PREMIUM] TREK 16TH APRIL 2025



Turning 50 is a milestone and Ms. Pranali Patkar chose to mark it not with a party, but with a journey to one of the world's highest alpine lakes. **A solo traveller from Mumbai and a returning Nomad, she had once stood at Everest Base Camp with us.** This April, she set her sights on something new: the Annapurna Circuit with Tilicho Lake.



This private, premium trek was crafted around her pace, her comfort, and her spirit. From carefully mapped routes to quiet moments by Tilicho's icy blue waters, her journey was as much inward as it was across landscapes. And we're grateful she chose us again to be part of her story.

Each trek here is introduced as a gateway into a different mood and experience of Ladakh — spiritual, cultural, wild, and extreme.

Sham Valley Trek– Where Ladakh Smiles First



This is where your Ladakhi story can begin.

Far from the silence of solitude and the struggle of summits, Sham Valley hums with life. Think golden apricot orchards glowing under the sun, whitewashed homes adorned with prayer flags, and monasteries where the smell of juniper hangs in the air.

Locals greet you like family. Trails wind through barley fields, not boulder fields. It's where the journey is as soft as the sunlight and as rich as the heritage. For those curious about Ladakh's cultural core, Sham Valley is the warmest welcome.

Markha Valley Trek – The Trail Through Living Legends

Jagged snowfields, Ice-crusted ridgelines, Glacial valleys carved over millennia, but in all this rawness, there's still grace—sunlight bouncing off snow like a mirror to the heavens, silence that presses gently on your thoughts, and the overwhelming realization of how small and sacred this moment is.

Kang Yatse II Expedition (6250M) – The Summit Where Dreams Stand Tall

There's the thrill of reaching a summit, and then there's the story of becoming someone who could. Kang Yatse II is a non-technical but high-altitude expedition.

At 6,250 meters, it asks for your commitment, patience, and humility. But it gives back tenfold: sweeping panoramas of Zaskar and Karakoram, an inner transformation that only the high Himalayas can spark, and a quiet pride that never leaves you.
