As we step into October, it's that exciting shift the season of summits, sunrises, and snow is here.







KEDARKANTHA - THE CLASSIC WINTER SUMMIT

If there's one trek that defines winter in the Himalayas, it's **Kedarkantha**. At 12,500 ft, this summit stands as an open invitation to first-timers, families, and seasoned trekkers alike.

What makes it magical is its rhythm: you begin under pine forests draped in snow, cross frozen streams that crackle beneath your boots, and reach a summit that glows golden with the first light of dawn.

For many, Kedarkantha is their first tryst with snow, camping, and the realization that the cold can feel oddly comforting when you're surrounded by good company and starlit silence.

"You never forget your first winter sunrise from Kedarkantha," one of our trekkers said last year.

BRAHMATAL - WHERE REFLECTIONS MEET MOUNTAINS

A journey that feels like poetry in motion, **Brahmatal** is the kind of winter trek that quietly takes your breath away.

Every bend on this trail opens to a different frame — snow-clad ridges, oak forests heavy with frost, and the mirror-like Brahmatal Lake reflecting **Mt. Trishul and Mt. Nanda Ghunti** in all their glory. It's not the hardest trek, but it's one of the most rewarding.

Nights here are silent, broken only by the crunch of fresh snow. Mornings are slow, with clouds floating low and peaks glowing pink.

If you're someone who loves photography, solitude, and mountain stillness, Brahmatal is your canvas.

KUARI PASS - THE LORD CURZON TRAIL

Some trails have stories built into them, **Kuari Pass** is one of them.

Once explored by Lord Curzon, this trail gives you sweeping views of some of India's highest peaks — **Nanda Devi, Dronagiri, and Kamet.**

The trek is not too steep, not too long, but perfectly balanced, ideal for those looking to graduate from beginner treks to something with more depth. You walk through ancient forests, open meadows blanketed in snow, and ridgelines that make you feel like you're walking in the clouds.

SANDAKPHU - THE TREK OF FOUR GIANTS

There are few places on Earth where you can see four of the world's five tallest peaks in a single frame.

Sandakphu, straddling the Indo-Nepal border, is one of them.

On clear days, you can spot Everest, Kanchenjunga, Lhotse, and Makalu standing shoulder to shoulder, like a mountain orchestra. The trail itself is surreal, winding through rhododendron forests, tea gardens, and quaint villages where you sip hot chai looking across two countries at once.
