## WHY WEDDING FILMS MATTER

Your wedding day is fast, emotional, and filled with fleeting moments.

Photos capture stillness. Films capture feeling.

The laughter, the tears, the in-between glances, the sound of vows and speeches, video lets you relive them all.

## THE WEDDING DAY: VIDEO TIMELINE & TIPS

#### **Getting Ready**

- Choose a space with soft, natural light
- Keep the room simple and clutter-free
- Have details ready: dress, suit, rings, flowers, invites

#### Ceremony

- Microphones make a huge difference for vows & speeches
- Consider an unplugged ceremony, it's intimate & timeless
- Pause after your first kiss for the perfect cinematic shot

#### **Couple Portraits & Golden Hour**

- Allow at least 20–30 minutes
- In Sydney, golden hour is usually 5:30-7pm depending on season
- Relax, laugh, be yourselves, the film captures the magic

#### **Reception & Party**

- Remind speakers to keep the mic close
- First dance: even a few twirls under fairy lights = magic
- Dance floor candids are pure storytelling gold



## WHAT MAKES A WEDDING FEEL MAGICAL

#### Lighting

Soft, natural, golden. Fairy lights & candles add texture.

#### Sound

Vows, laughter, music. Crystal clear audio brings the film alive.

#### Time

A relaxed timeline = joyful, natural moments.

#### Style

Cinematic Highlight Film (emotional storytelling)
Documentary Edit (long-form coverage)
Both = the perfect balance





## NSW VENUE INSPIRATION

Some of our favourite places across New South Wales and how they shine on film:

#### **Sydney Icons**

Watsons Bay Boutique Hotel – ocean views, dreamy sunsets Doltone House, Darling Island – sleek city with Harbour Bridge views Royal Botanic Gardens – lush greenery with skyline peeks

#### **Hunter Valley**

Wineries & estates surrounded by golden hills
Dreamy sunsets that last forever
Perfect for cinematic wide shots

#### **Blue Mountains**

Clifftop lookouts and dramatic valleys Misty mornings & romantic golden light Rustic venues with cosy, intimate vibes

#### South Coast (e.g., Berry, Kiama, Jervis Bay)

White sandy beaches + turquoise waters Charming country halls and garden venues Relaxed, coastal energy on film

#### Southern Highlands (Bowral, Mittagong, Berrima)

Elegant country estates and manicured gardens
Autumn leaves and crisp air = cinematic colour palette
Perfect mix of luxury and nature

#### Northern NSW (Byron Bay, Tweed Valley)

Bohemian-chic beach vibes Rainforest backdrops and rolling hinterland hills Sun-drenched, golden and carefree

(Tip: Wherever you book, check sunset times as golden hour footage is unforgettable.)



#### Do I really need a videographer if I already have a photographer?

Yes! Photos freeze moments; films bring them to life. Movement, sound, laughter, music. video captures the emotion in ways still images cannot.

#### When should I book my videographer?

As early as possible, especially for popular NSW venues. Many couples book 12–18 months in advance.

#### How do you work with photographers?

We collaborate closely with photographers to ensure we complement each other without getting in the way. Your day should feel seamless.

#### How long will we wait for our wedding film?

Typically 6–10 weeks for the highlight film. Full ceremony edits or longer films may take slightly longer.

#### What if it rains?

We always have a plan for weather. Rain can even create magical, cinematic shots. Umbrellas, reflections, and cozy moments indoors make your film unique.

#### Can we request specific shots?

Absolutely! We love hearing what moments matter most to you. From emotional glances to family hugs, your story is personal and tailored.

#### Do you travel outside Sydney?

Yes, NSW is our playground! From the Blue Mountains to the South Coast and Northern NSW, We capture weddings in all kinds of stunning locations, including overseas.

#### Do we need to stick to a strict timeline?

A relaxed timeline creates the best film. Cramming too many moments into a short period often leads to rushed shots.

### MISTAKES TO AVOID

Not allocating enough time for portraits & golden hour

Golden hour is your friend. Build in at least 20-30 minutes for relaxed couple shots.

Underestimating the importance of sound

Clear audio makes or breaks a wedding film. Make sure microphones are allowed for vows and speeches.

Trying to capture everything yourself

DIY filming or asking guests to take videos rarely works, focus on enjoying your day; the professional captures it.

Overloading your timeline

Less stress = more natural moments. Prioritise key moments and trust your videographer.

Not thinking about lighting

Dark, harsh, or mixed lighting can ruin a shot. Check your venue lighting and ask for small adjustments if needed.

Skipping a planning guide

Couples often forget to plan "photo/video moments." This leads to missed opportunities. A small prep checklist goes a long way.

Not considering travel time between locations

Especially in NSW, distances can be significant (e.g., Blue Mountains to Sydney). Factor in travel to avoid rushed filming.
