Focus went public in 2018, delivering top quartile results to public shareholders.

At Roivant Sciences, Anita played a pivotal role in driving value creation across healthcare services and technology, both domestically and internationally. Roivant went public in 2021, at a \$7.3B valuation.

Anita started her career at McKinsey & Co., and then in middle-market private equity investing at Audax Private Equity.
