



THE TERRITORY

The Karst and the Sea

Trieste (Italy) and Koper (Slovenia) are located in the Northern Adriatic, at the crossroads between Central Europe and the Mediterranean

The two cities are 20 km apart (about 30 minutes by car)

The area combines:

- A mild coastal climate with Mediterranean influence
- Rolling hills and karst landscapes ideal for viticulture
- A rich blend of Italian, Slovenian, and Central European cultural heritage




Hospitality
