Funding Range: \$30,000 – \$1,500,000.

Offers development and production funding for feature-length documentaries with strong storytelling and artistic vision. Submissions are accepted year-round via a Letter of Inquiry.

For photo and video journalism.

Funding Range: \$5,000 – \$10,000.

The Pulitzer Center's Global Reporting Grants support in-depth reporting projects, including photojournalism and video journalism, that cover global issues.

For video projects.

Funding Range: \$5,000 – \$1 million.
