BASIC JOB DESCRIPTION:

We're seeking a pastor who has a passion for Jesus Christ and Scripture, a love for people, a heart for missions, and who knows how to lead with wisdom and vision.

- He will provide Spiritual leadership, honor Christ and his Word, and have a heart and mindset to reach others for Christ, locally and globally
- He should also have a strong desire to equip others and to lead the congregation in discipleship

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Pastoral Ministries

- Prepare and present sermons for a weekly Sunday worship service
- Perform weddings, funerals, and baptisms as requested by congregants
- Lead communion services (currently monthly)
- Arrange for pulpit supply when absent (typically from within the congregation)
- Provide doctrinal leadership and fully support our doctrinal statement
- Lead and oversee Bible studies/discipleship groups (there has been a mid-week adult Bible study offered during the school year—morning and evening sessions of the same study)
- Coordinate visitation ministry

Administrative Ministry

- Review and respond to official church correspondence
- Oversee and direct the planning of special services (e.g., Christian-observed holidays)

Board Ministry

- Serve on the Board of Elders
- Maintain positive working relationships with all board members
- Provide spiritual leadership to the board
- Review and provide input to fellowship roll (membership) applications

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Meet all elder requirements in Titus 1:5-9, 1 Tim. 3:1-7, and 1 Peter 5:1-4
- Agree to the church's statement of faith
- Baccalaureate degree or higher in pastoral ministry or related field (or equivalent experience)
