



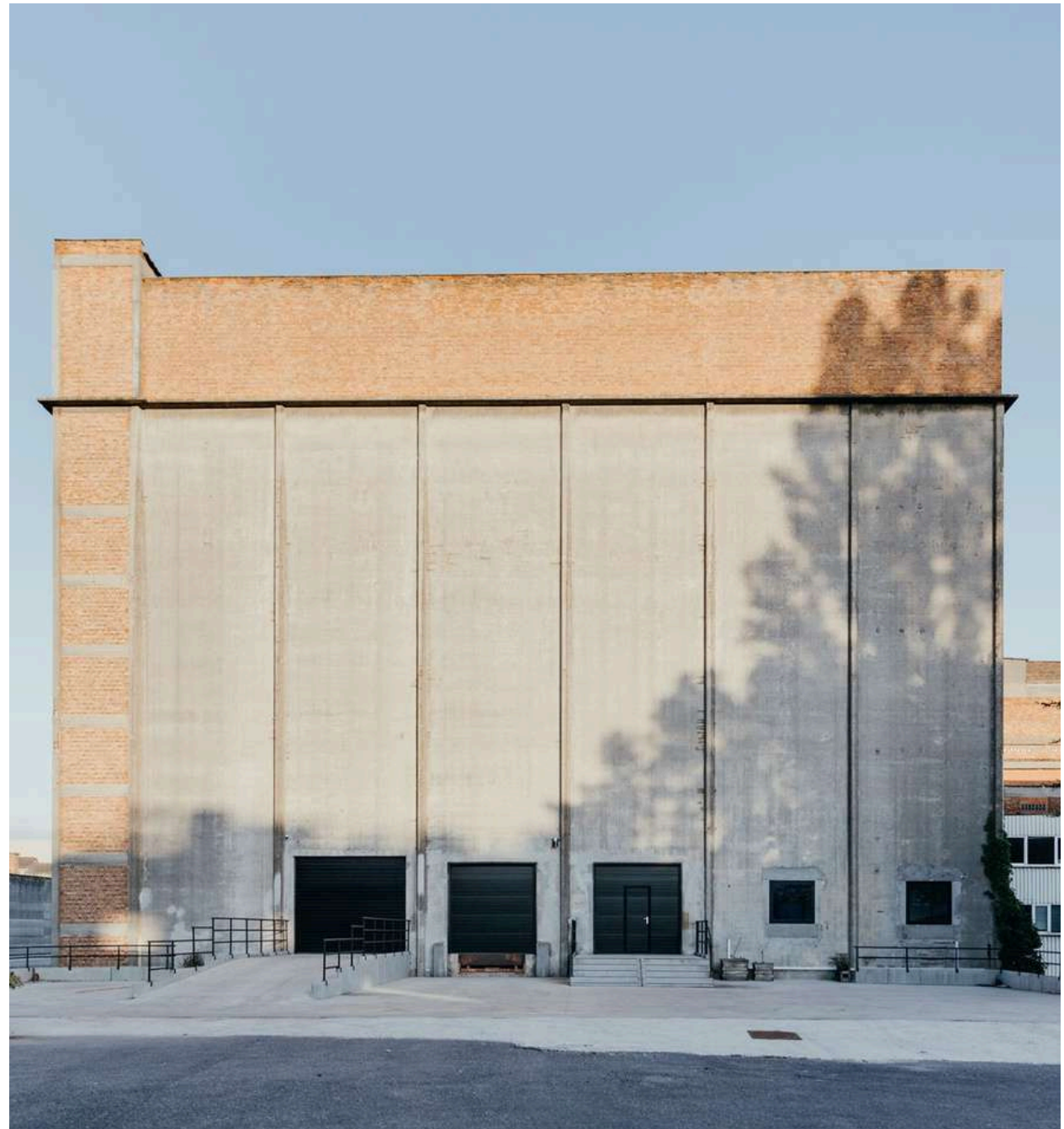

Our *History*

On the left bank of Brussels' outer harbour, in Neder-Over-Heembeek, stood a large brewery developed in the 1930s that once employed over two hundred people. Water, beer, malt, and Meudon lemonades were produced here at industrial scale, making the site a key part of the area's economic life.

When the Marly water source could no longer supply sufficient quantities, production gradually came to a halt. By the 1970s, brewing and lemonade production had ceased, and the brewery closed its doors some thirty years ago. This marked the end of one chapter—and the beginning of another.

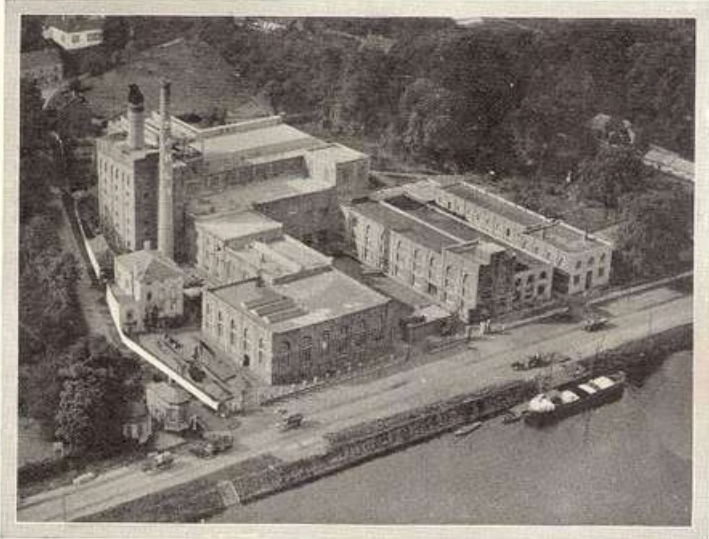
Two young entrepreneurs, active in art packing and transportation, acquired the abandoned site to establish their offices and workshops. What followed was a long-term commitment: seven years of transformation to bring this derelict industrial building back to life, making it worthy of hosting and showcasing exceptional works of art.
