Reimbursement

Gentle Reminders

Please be sure that when submitting attendance, you are also submitting the sign in and sign outs at the same time. When providers start submitting documents on separate dates then it cuts into the processing time and creates double work and delays in reimbursement having to go back and search.

Also providers please verify that parents are signing their children in at drop off/pick up with their names and not "mom and dad" or initials only, they should be first and last names of parent or guardian.

Program Services

Parent Fees for siblings and questions for eligibility

Parent fees for households that renew or enroll after 10.1.2025 will now be tied to the youngest child on the account. That means that you will often see a sibling certificate of care that shows a parent fee of \$0. This is not a mistake. The family parent fee will appear on the youngest child's certificate, even if the child is not enrolled at your location.

If you have a question regarding child eligibility (ex: is child covered for PT or FT childcare, is this parent fee correct, etc), please first reach out to the specialist name shown at the bottom of the childcare certificate.

Notices of Change

A question has come up related to the Notices of Change that would notify providers when a family is coming up on their renewal of childcare services. These notices are no longer being uploaded to the Provider SharePoint folders, but are still being uploaded through the Provider Portal Document library under the folder title: SR and VPK correspondence folder.


Providers should also be able to see households approaching their end of year via the Provider Portal under the following provider portal work queues:

SR Eligibility Redeterminations

The SR Eligibility Redetermination menu allows providers to view enrollments with “upcoming” or “past due” redeterminations. These queues are for informational purposes only and aid providers in knowing when an enrolled child is reaching the end of their School Readiness eligibility.

Upcoming Eligibility Redeterminations

To see the enrollments with upcoming eligibility redeterminations, navigate to **Enrollments > Manage SR Enrollments > Redeterminations > Upcoming Redeterminations**.




Redetermination records will only appear in the Provider Portal Upcoming Redetermination queue when:

- Child eligibility status is Eligible
- Child enrollment status is Enrolled or Pending Family Acceptance
- The redetermination is within 45 days from the due date

Past Due Eligibility Redeterminations

To see the enrollments with past due eligibility redeterminations, navigate to **Enrollments > Manage SR Enrollments > Redeterminations > Past Due Redeterminations**.



Redetermination records will only appear in the Provider Portal Past Due Redetermination queue when:

- Child eligibility status is Eligible
- Child enrollment status is Enrolled or Pending Family Acceptance
- The redetermination is at least one day past the redetermination due date

CLASS Assessment


DEL has changed the reporting process




VPK Child Assessments for PM-2 are in process for many. Be sure you go over the results with the families. Also, use the information from the assessments to guide your teaching.





ASQ Child Screenings

Please be sure to check your Provider Portal, Enrollments, Developmental Screening, Incomplete que at least 2 times a week to see what screening are coming due.



Be sure you share the ASQ results with the parents, even if the parent did the screening. They only see the results when you show them.

If you need assistance with ASQ Screenings, contact Ivonne at Ivonne.Orengo@elcofswfl.org.

If the child on your Screening Report is no longer attending or never attended, let Ivonne know right away. Don't wait until the screening is late, you will get a Non-Compliance.
