

## What is a Site Assessment?

A site assessment is a comprehensive examination of all aspects of safety and security. This includes a detailed analysis of processes, procedures, training, equipment, technology and physical security. An SEC consultant will visit the designated building site(s) and evaluate vulnerabilities associated with physical security and emergency preparedness.

#### How does the site assessment work?

SEC will thoroughly examine your facility, including the following:

- · The surrounding area for hazards
- Internal and external design features
- Existing technical and physical security measures
- Review of your current emergency operations plan and trainings
- Relevant safety and security policies and procedures
- Emergency equipment
