- Includes: Full use of a dedicated meeting room with WiFi, water, refreshments, tea/coffee, electricity, full lunch, and refreshments, behind-the-scenes tour
- Donation: €750+

Option 3: Biodiversity Seminar and Volunteering

- Duration: 6 hours (10:00 am 4:00 pm)
- Group Size: Up to 14 people
- Availability: Thursdays only
- Includes: Full use of a dedicated meeting room with WiFi, water, refreshments, tea/coffee, electricity, full lunch, and refreshments, seminar on Irish native animals, behind-the-scenes tour
- Donation: €1000+

HOUSEKEEPING GUIDELINES

- Health & Safety: Follow all health and safety notices and staff instructions.
- Medical Conditions: Inform us of any medical conditions prior to arrival.
- Animal Handling: Do not enter enclosures with wild animals.
- Toilets: Located in the main barn.
- Children: Volunteers must be 18 or older.
- Dress Code: Wear wellington boots, waterproof trousers, and weatherappropriate clothing. PPE will be provided.
- Personal Belongings: Store personal items securely; KWR is not responsible for loss or damage.
- Injuries/Accidents: Report immediately; complete an accident report if necessary.
- Smoking: Not permitted inside buildings.
- Confidentiality: Maintain confidentiality of all privileged information.
- · Photography: Ask staff before taking photographs for social media.
- Fire Safety: Assembly point is in the paddock at the rear of the facility.
