CRITERIA

- a four year combined Grade Point Average (GPA) of 80.0 or greater
- participation in **Plattsburgh High School Varsity Soccer or Baseball/Softball** and/or at least two year of participation in **PHS Drama Club** and/or at least two years of participation in the PHS Chorus
- Commitment to attend either a two or four year undergraduate college
- An *exceptional personality* and an overall enjoyment for life
- Demonstrates leadership qualities, extensive involvement in school activities, and a concern for others

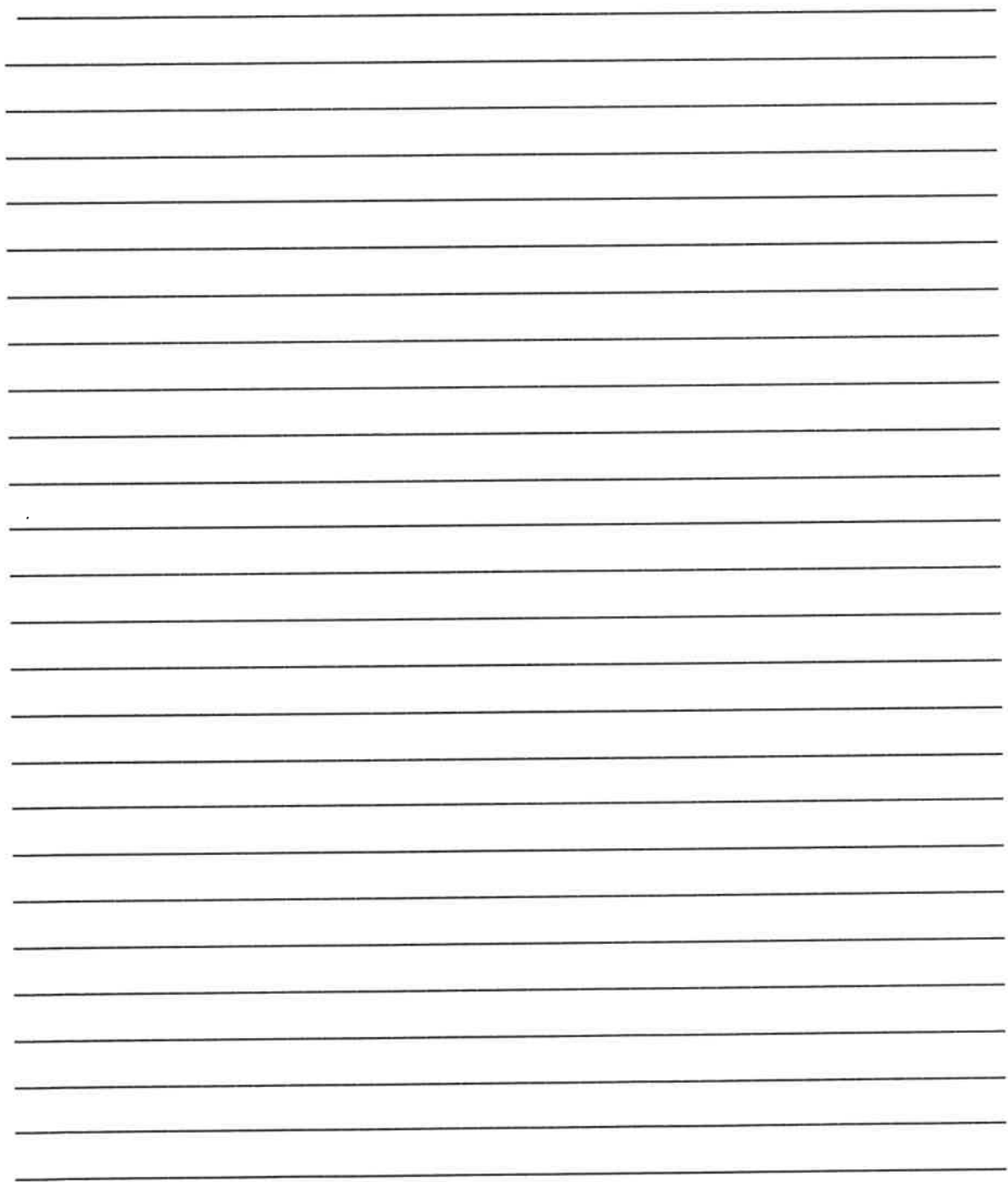
