Communion & Ordinance of Humility

We pray you will be blessed by this special service. The foot washing service at the beginning of the worship is a time to be in a place of humility, unity, and love, in preparation to partake of the Lord's Supper.

All who have committed their lives to Jesus are invited to participate in this time of soul searching, conviction of sin, and of the blessed assurance of forgiveness.

At the beginning of the service there will be an invitation to divide up into rooms and follow the example of Jesus in washing another's feet. Each is partnered up with another and there will be assistants ready to help if needed. Towels, basins, and water are provided. For those that would rather remain in the sanctuary there will be a reading on the life and death of Jesus.

You can then return to the sanctuary using this time to reflect on what Jesus has done for you. *So after He had washed their feet, and had taken His garments... He said unto them, Know ye what I have done to you? You call me Master and Lord: and you say well; for so I am. If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; you also should wash one another's feet. For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you.* [John 13:12-15]

The worship service will continue with music and teaching. At the end of the sermon there will be an invitation to partake in the communion (juice & bread) service that is open to all who have accepted Jesus as their Savior.
