Habitat for Humanity's 40th Jimmy & Rosalynn Carter Work Project will take place in Atlanta, Georgia.

What

For the first time since 1988, the Jimmy & Rosalynn Carter Work Project will return to Atlanta. On May 3-8, 2026, Atlanta Habitat for Humanity will bring volunteers, partners and affordable housing advocates together to build 24 new single-family homes and townhomes in just five days. This milestone event will kick off construction at Langston Park, Atlanta Habitat's newest planned community in the historic Sylvan Hills neighborhood.

Langston Park represents a bold step forward in expanding affordable homeownership, introducing modern, sustainable, townhome-style living for the first time in Atlanta Habitat's history. With easy access to MARTA, the Atlanta Beltline and nearby green spaces, families will thrive in a safe, stable and connected community.
