

PHOTOGRAPHY VOLUNTEER

Atlanta Habitat is occasionally in need of quality photos of the build-starts, wall-raising, and dedication days for our website, social media outlets, and collateral materials.

ROLE

- Volunteers will assist Atlanta Habitat staff by photographing build starts inside our warehouse as well as wall-raising days and dedication ceremonies at the build site.
- Volunteers will follow specific photography guidelines in an effort to obtain the required pictures.

SCHEDULE

- Atlanta Habitat build-starts typically occur on Thursdays and Saturdays at 7:30 am inside of our warehouse.
- Wall-raising and dedication days typically occur on Thursdays and Saturdays at sites located throughout the City of Atlanta and South Fulton County.
- Dedications typically start around 11:30 am and last approximately one hour.
- Wall-raising shifts typically start around 9:30 am and last for approximately four hours.
- We ask that Photography Volunteers arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of their volunteer shift.
- Photography shifts for other special events are scheduled as needed.

REQUIREMENTS

- Review the *Photography Volunteer Handbook*, which will be provided after registering for a photography event.
- Photographers will be given credit for your work that we use on the website or in collateral materials. Photos can be used for your portfolio.
- Provide your own camera.
- Adhere to Atlanta Habitat guidelines for specific photography needs.
- Upload photos through a SharePoint link shared by Atlanta Habitat in the event confirmation e-mail within 72 hours.
