LOCAL FOOD BANKS AND PANTRIES IN NYC

If you are in or near New York City, these organizations can provide immediate food relief:

- Feeding America Network: You can use their tool to find your local food bank and then check their partners (pantries, soup kitchens) for distribution times and locations.
- · Catholic Charities Brooklyn & Queens: They operate a large Food Pantry Network and distribution centers. You can call their general number for information: (718) 722-6001.
- NYC Food Bank: You can search their resources online for nearby pantries and soup kitchens.

RESOURCES FOR ONGOING OR EMERGENCY SNAP ISSUES

If the issue is specifically related to a delay or cutoff in your SNAP benefits, here are actions you can take:

- Check State/Local Social Services: Contact your local Depatment of Social Services (or Human Resources Administration in NYC) office. They manage SNAP benefits and will have the most up-to-date information on delays or alternative assistance programs.
- Apply for Emergency Food: Check local food pantries or soup kitchens, as they provide
- immediate help separate from the SNAP program.
 Check other programs: Look into the WIC program if you have children under five or are pregnant, and local Emergency Assistance programs (like the One Shot Deal in NYC) that might offer one-time cash help for expenses.

IMMEDIATE FOOD ASSISTANCE

The most direct way to get food right now is through local food pantries and community kitchens.

- Food Bank for New York City:
 - They have a network of 800 locations for free groceries and hot meals across all five boroughs.
 - Find a pantry near you: Use their official website tool to browse locations, hours, and SNAP. support services.
- NYC's Food Help Map & 311:

 You can call 311 (available 24/7) to ask for information about emergency food program locations and hours of operation.
 - The city also offers an interactive Food Help NYC Map online.
- Catholic Charities Brooklyn and Queens
 - They operate a large Food Pantry Network and food distribution centers in Brooklyn and Queens.
 - You can call their Call Center at 718-722-6001 for information and referrals to their programs and other organizations.

STATE AND NATIONAL HOTLINES

These hotlines are excellent for quickly finding the nearest resource by phone.

- Call 2-1-1: This is a national helpline that connects you with local food pantries and essential community services in your area. It is free, confidential, and available in multiple languages.
- **National Hunger Hotline:**
 - Call 1-866-3-HUNGRY (1-866-348-6479) or 1-877-8-HAMBRE (1-877-842-6273).
 - Available Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 8 PM Eastern Time, in English and Spanish.
- Feeding America:
 - You can enter your zip code on their website to find the local food bank partnering with their nationwide network, which will share locations and hours of nearby food distributions.

APPLYING FOR OTHER ASSISTANCE

For longer-term or emergency financial help,, families may be eligible for other programs.

- Temporary Assistance (TA)/ Cash Assistance:
 - This program provides temporary financial help for needy adults and children, including Family
 Assistance (FA) for families with a minor child, and Safety Net Assistance (SNA) for single
 adults or childless couples.

 - You can apply online through AccessHRA or visit a Benefit Access Center.
 DSS OneNumber: Call (718)557-1399 (Mon-Fri, 8AM-5PM) for information and assistance.
 WIC (Women, Infant and Children):
- - WIC provides healthy supplemental food, nutrition counseling, and health care referrals for low-income pregnant people and those with children up to age five.

Important Note on SNAP: While federal judges have ordered the administration to release the SNAP payments that were at risk of being cut off as of November 1, the situation is fluid and lines at food pantries are long. Please continue to check your EBT account at NJFamiliesFirst.com or call 800-997-3333 if you are in New Jersey or check your local state's specific guidance for the lates on when payments will resume.
