## Additional Policies for the Registration of .PL Domains (.COM.PL, .ORG.PL, .NET.PL, .INFO.PL, .BIZ.PL)

The registration of domain names under the .PL top-level domain (including third-level domains such as .com.pl, .org.pl, .net.pl, .info.pl and .biz.pl) is subject to the applicable terms and conditions established by the Research and Academic Computer Network ("NASK"), the authoritative registry for .PL domain names. These rules form an integral part of each domain name registration and are incorporated into the OpusDNS GmbH Master Service Agreement and the Registration Agreement.

## 1. Authorisation for Registry Operations and Domain Management (Consent)

By submitting a registration request for a .PL domain name, you grant to OpusDNS GmbH - who has concluded a cooperation agreement with NASK regarding internet domain names - the authorisation to perform any and all actions required for the registration, administration and technical functionality of the domain name with NASK.

This includes, in particular:

- registration, modification and deletion of the domain name,
- changes to registrant data,
- updates to technical information, including nameserver data,
- processing, transmission and updating of registration data,
- all technical and legal actions required for the proper operation and maintenance of the domain name.

NASK may provide registration data to OpusDNS GmbH and/or Resellers as necessary for these activities.

## 2. Reseller Responsibilities in Multi-Level Sales Chains

Where you act as a Reseller, you expressly:

- guarantee that all required consents of the actual Domain Name Holder for the registration, administration and processing of registration data have been duly obtained before submitting any .PL registration request;
- ensure that these .PL-specific conditions are fully passed on to your own customers, including any downstream resellers;
- ensure that the Domain Name Holder has authorised your to perform all necessary actions related to the domain name and to instruct the Registrar accordingly;
- confirm that such authorisation remains valid for the entire lifetime of the domain name;
- agree to provide proof of these consents to the Registrar upon request.

The registration and continued operation of .PL domain names require that these authorisations exist at all times.
