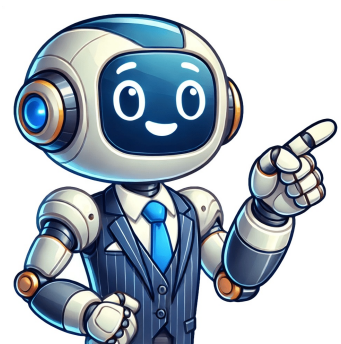


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This text is about three experts in child development: John W. Santrock, Kirby Deater-Deckard, and Jennifer E. Lansford. They have written several books on the subject, including "Child Development" and "Life-Span Development". Santrock received his Ph.D. from the University of Minnesota and has taught at several universities. He has also worked as a school psychologist. Deater-Deckard is a Professor at the University of Massachusetts Amherst and has published over 200 papers on child development. Lansford is a Research Professor at Duke University and has also written extensively on child development, including the impact of parenting styles on children's behavior.

=====Dr. Lansford studied mothers, fathers, and children from nine different countries including China, Colombia, Italy, Jordan, Kenya, Philippines, Sweden, Thailand, and the United States. She also consulted with UNICEF on parenting programs in several developing countries and helped create international standards for such programs. Furthermore, Dr. Lansford serves as an editor for several academic journals and has held various leadership roles including chairing a U.S. National Institute of Health study section. Dr. John Santrock received his Ph.D. from the University of Minnesota's College of Education and Human Development. He taught at universities in Charleston and Georgia before joining the faculty at the University of Texas at Dallas. Dr. Santrock has also worked as a school psychologist and currently teaches educational psychology to undergraduate students every year. In 2006, he received an award for excellence in teaching from the University of Texas at Dallas. Dr. Jennifer Lansford is a Research Professor at Duke University's Sanford School of Public Policy and Faculty Fellow of the Center for Child and Family Policy. She studied parenting programs and helped create standards for their development. Dr. Lansford has also been involved in various leadership roles including chairing an editorial board for Developmental Psychology. Dr. Lansford has received her Ph.D. in Developmental Psychology from the University of Michigan in the year 2000. She is a prolific researcher with more than 200 publications to her credit, focusing particularly on how family and social influences affect young people's behavior problems during childhood and adolescence. The Parenting Across Cultures Project is another significant undertaking she leads, involving nine countries including China, Colombia, Italy, Jordan, Kenya, Philippines, Sweden, Thailand, and the United States. Moreover, Dr. Lansford has been a consultant for UNICEF on parenting programs in several low- and middle-income countries, and helped establish international standards for these initiatives. She also holds leadership roles in various academic journals and organizations, such as chairing the U.S. National Institutes of Health Psychosocial Development study section. Dr. Deater-Deckard is a professor at the University of Massachusetts Amherst, where he leads graduate programs in developmental science and neuroscience, and serves as director of the Healthy Development Initiative in Springfield. He has also authored more than 200 publications exploring biological and environmental factors that affect children's development in various aspects, including social-emotional and cognitive outcomes. Dr. Deater-Deckard is a fellow of the Association for Psychological Science and principal investigator on several longitudinal studies funded by the National Institutes of Health and US-Israel Binational Science Foundation. He has served as a consultant on various research projects globally and is a scientific reviewer for the Institute of Education Sciences, among other roles. Both Dr. Lansford and her husband Chris are surgeons who specialize in head and neck cancer, while their two children Katherine and Nick are teenagers with ages 16 and 13 respectively.

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
