(22) Is someone who crawls on their belly more guided or someone who walks upright on a straight path? This means: (23-25) Say, "He is the One Who created you and gave you hearing, sight, and heart." But they are not grateful. And they say, "When will this threat come if you are telling the truth?" (26) Say, "The knowledge of the Hour is only with Allah. And I am only a warner to explain." Meaning: (27-28) When they see the punishment approaching, their faces will be dark and they will be told, "This is what you used to ask for." Say, "If Allah were to kill me or those with me, or if He gave us mercy, then we would enter Paradise. But who can protect the disbelievers from the severe punishment?" Say, "He is the One Who is merciful; we believe in Him and rely on Him. And you will soon know who are in clear error." (29) Say, "Do you want to hear an example? If your water becomes dry, then who can give you flowing water?" (30) Note: I've paraphrased the text to make it easier to understand, while trying to preserve the original meaning and context. The heavens, as seen from earth, are adorned with stars. God made these stars a source of guidance against Satan and also prepared Hellfire for those who disbelieve. For those who deny their Lord, there will be severe punishment in the form of the Fire. When they are thrown into Hell, they will hear its roaring flames and will be consumed by its intensity. It is so hot that it almost breaks apart from its own heat. Every time a group of disbelievers is thrown into Hell, the keepers of Hell ask them if they had been warned about their fate when a messenger came to them in the past. The disbelievers replied that indeed there was a messenger who warned them but they rejected him and said: "God has not sent anyone." They also said that if only they had listened to this messenger, they would have escaped the Fire. Eventually, they realize their mistakes and acknowledge their sins. But it is too late for repentance, and God's mercy is far from those who are condemned to Hell. Those who fear their Lord while no one sees them and before punishment arrives will receive forgiveness and a great reward. However, this favor will not be given to the disbelievers. As for the disbelievers, when they were on earth, they knew that God had sent messengers with warnings. They denied these messengers and instead thought them to be in error. When they are brought before God's Judgment, they will realize their mistakes but it will be too late. God is fully aware of all hearts and knows what secrets people hide within themselves. The truth is that only God can create the heavens and earth. He is All-Powerful over His affairs. It is only through Him that you have been given this world with its various paths, so walk on them. And it is to Him that your final return will be made. Do not forget the favors you have received from Him, nor take lightly His power. If God were to unleash His wrath upon you, who could stop Him? If He were to let loose against you the punishment of a day when wind would torment you and kill some people, who could survive it? Do not think that you are safe just because your souls are not visible or that you have no fear. This is just like God's power over His creation. Is it not enough for them to be given this earth with its many paths, so walk on them? It is the return to Him at the end of all paths that should scare them. And is it not sufficient for them to be reminded about their accountability to God when He sends against them a storm that would kill some and torment others? You have been given the earth as your home, so go through its various valleys and eat from its fruits. It is ultimately towards Him that you will return after death. "You will soon see how terrible the consequences are for those who ignore My warnings (18). In fact, previous nations that rejected their prophets were destroyed, and now you should consider the bad fate that awaits those who reject Me (19). Don't they notice the birds flying above them? Who else could keep them from falling except Allah, the Most Merciful? Indeed, He sees and knows everything (20). What kind of protector is this for you, one that will save you except through Allah's mercy? Those who reject Him are only deluding themselves (21). Who can provide for your needs if Allah withholds His provision? No one, not even the idolaters who think they're self-sufficient (22). Which path do you walk on - one that leads to stumbling and falling, or one that is straight and true? (23) Say: "Allah created you from nothing, gave you hearing and sight, and a heart to be grateful. Yet, few of you are truly grateful" (24). Say again: "He caused you to grow on earth, and will gather you back to Him" (25). They ask when the promised day of judgment will come, if you're really truthful (26). Say: "The knowledge of that day is with Allah alone. I'm only a clear warning and reminder" (27). When they see the fulfillment of their doom up close, the faces of those who rejected Him will be blackened, and it will be said to them: "This is what you used to long for!" (28). You should consider this: if Allah destroys me and my companions, or shows mercy to us, who can protect the rejectors from a painful punishment? (29). Say: "He is the Most Merciful". We place our trust in Allah, and we rely on His mercy. As Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) said to them: "Allah is the Most Merciful One, whom we believe in, and to Whom we surrender ourselves; therefore, you will know who is wandering in plain error." (30) I say again: "How do you think? If your water supply were cut off and disappeared into the ground, then who could bring back the flowing water to you except Allah?"
