Our size categories include small, medium, large, and upper-large SUVs. The test sizes are determined by multiplying the width and length of a vehicle. We used Audi SUVs for our tests, but since size segmentation is brand-agnostic, our results will apply to other makes and models in the same category. Due to limited availability, two vehicles featured are Sportback (coupe) versions of their full-size counterparts. This minor difference won't significantly impact our findings. \*\*Test 1: Adult Test\*\* This test shows how well adults fit in the second row of these SUVs. It gives you an idea of what to expect if you frequently need to carry people. \*\*Test 2: Bicycle Test\*\* For those who ride bicycles, knowing whether a bike fits easily into their car is important. This test demonstrates how well a bicycle can fit and whether you can also seat an additional passenger in the second row. \*\*Test 3: Christmas Day Test\*\* This test simulates loading luggage on Christmas Day while accommodating family members. We'll evaluate the room available in the second row with a rear-facing baby seat and assess the compromise required in the front passenger seat to fit that seat. These tests should give you an idea of the space available in small, medium, large, and upper-large SUVs. Our results show that large SUVs are indeed large, but since everyone's needs differ, these tests will help you determine which size suits your lifestyle. While highlighting dimensions and cargo capacity, this list might not cover every model to keep it concise. Some vehicles may boast higher ground clearance due to unique suspension designs.
