## Chief architect premier x9 library

**Chief architect premier x9. Chief architect library files. Chief architect x11. Chief architect premier x13. Chief architect x14.**

Given article text here I have downloaded the library catalogue inside x3, but I am unsure how to export the folders so that they can be easily transferred in case my computer needs to be formatted. Currently, the size of the Architecture folder is significantly smaller when using CALIBZ, which is 60MB, compared to 218MB when using CALIB. I think the entire Architecture folder should weigh around 1GB, but I don't know why it's not the case. I've learned that using "export library" is not effective for creating a complete backup of your current library. Instead, I should copy the entire "Chief Architect Premier X3 Data" folder to an external hard drive or DVD. However, I am having trouble locating the export library command and I need help exporting my custom "user catalog" to a second licensed version of Chief. A possible explanation for the size difference is that ".calibz" files are compressed versions of the library. It's recommended to ensure all items are downloaded and not displayed as previews in your library browser, as previews are not exported. Exporting eliminates the need for paths to textures and other referenced files to be remembered, making it a suitable option for user libraries. For Chief subscribed content, copying the 'Documents\Chief Architect Premier X3 Data' folder to a backup location should work just fine. However, I am still unsure about how to install the new data folder. Chief Architect Premier users can download core catalogs and bonus/manufacturer content for their designs. To access Library Browser, select View> Library Browser (X14 and prior) or have a plan open (X15-X16). Install Core Content by selecting Library> Install Core Content, which may take time due to the large data size. Once installed, a Catalog Update Summary dialog will display. To obtain bonus and manufacturer content: 1. Select Library> Get Additional Content Online. 2. Log in to your Chief Architect account (Forgot My Password for password reset). 3. Browse categories and expand contents. 4. Free catalogs don't require SSA, while others require active Support & Software Assurance or a software subscription. 5. Click on thumbnails for full catalog overviews, like the catalog if it meets expectations. Download bonus or manufacturer catalogs by clicking the Download Arrow symbol or button, selecting the desired Chief Architect version, and either opening or saving the .calibz file. If you opt to open the file, it should initiate the download and import process into Chief Architect automatically. If this doesn't happen, refer to the "Associating Plan, Layout, and Library Files with the Latest Version of Chief Architect or Home Designer" resource for assistance in importing libraries manually. When you save the file instead, you'll need to import the library manually by selecting Library > Import Library within the software and then browsing to where you saved the .calibz file. You can also group-select multiple .calibz files and import them simultaneously once one or more libraries have been imported. To access bonus and manufacturer catalogs, expand the relevant subfolders and select View Online Catalogs, or use the search bar to find a specific object or catalog. Installed objects will display with a particular icon and appear at the top of the list, while uninstalled objects will display with a globe icon and appear at the bottom. Select an uninstalled object, then view additional information in the Details section to download the catalog using your Chief Architect account credentials. To synchronize your product lines, update Chief Architect content if necessary. Access Library > Update Library Catalogs from the menu or use the tool at the bottom of the Library Browser to refresh all catalogs. In Chief Architect X15 and later versions, an icon will appear next to parent folders and top-left child folders when updates are available. Follow the same process or right-click on the icon and select "Update" as shown below. Note that on Macs, hold down the Control key while clicking for a right-click command. If you need guidance on Mac right-click commands, refer to Apple's resource: Right-Click on Mac. The program will gather information about installed content, then download available updates. Upon completion, one of two dialogs will appear: if catalogs were updated, a Catalog Update Summary dialog with additional details; if they were already up-to-date, an Information dialog stating so. Click "OK" in both cases. If you encounter an error message or the update fails, refer to the Related Articles section for further assistance or contact us.
