## Withstandingness answers quizlet

Withstandingness is the quality or state of being able to put up with or resist tough situations, like stresses and challenges. It's kinda like saying someone has strength or can bounce back quickly from hard times. The word "withstand" comes from Old English *wijstandan*, meaning "to go against" or "to stand firm". Adding the suffix *-ness* turns it into a noun that shows what state of being someone is in. In fancy talk, *withstandingness* means having the power to resist and keep going even when things get tough. *Withstand* stems from Old English, meaning to resist or oppose. The suffix *-ness* in *withstandingness* converts the verb into a noun describing a state or quality, signifying endurance or resistance to challenges. In materials science, *withstandingness* refers to the ability of materials to withstand environmental stresses. The antonym opposite to *withstandingness* is *fragility*, representing weakness or susceptibility to damage.
