Losing the key to your Bunker Hill safe can be frustrating if it contains valuable items that are now out of reach. The only way to access your safe is to obtain a replacement key from Harbor Freight Tools, the exclusive distributor of Bunker Hill safes. Do not attempt to force the safe open as this may cause permanent damage. To order a new key, find the model number of your safe on the lower right corner and write it down. Locate the small plastic panel on the front of your safe and push it aside to reveal a key code. Call Harbor Freight Technical Support with the model number, key code, name, and address, requesting a duplicate key. Pay for the new key using a credit card, and it will be mailed to you. It is recommended to keep override keys in a secure location outside the safe, as this can serve as an alternative method of opening your safe if you forget your digital code or the battery runs out. For added security, consider changing the default factory code for your digital keypad to prevent theft. The Bunker Hill floor safe features both a digital and manual entry-lock system. To open the safe using the digital keypad, enter the factory code by pressing the numbers "159" followed by the "A" key. Wait for the green light and then turn the knob once before opening the door. Alternatively, use the override key in situations where the digital pad malfunctions or the battery runs out. To change the combination on your Bunker Hill safe, follow the manufacturer's instructions in the product manual. The process may vary depending on your model. For example, resetting the combination on a Bunker Hill Security electronic digital safe model 45891 involves entering the current code and pressing the "A" or "B" key. Wait for the green light to turn on, then turn the knob within five seconds before opening the door. On some models, such as the Bunker Hill Security digital floor safe model 91006, you can reset the combination by following a similar process but opening the safe differently. After entering the code and waiting for the green light, turn the knob clockwise, then open the door using the handle or with a key if you prefer. Just turn the handle and knob, then push the door open. Hit the small red button to start fresh and come up with a brand-new code - read more on [reference.com!](#)
