Indian Hills, a neighborhood in Wichita, Kansas, is situated within the 25th district of the Kansas Senate and the 92nd and 95th districts of the Kansas House of Representatives. The city's Department of Park and Recreation manages the Indian Hills Greenway, a 3.2-acre section along the Arkansas River's west bank. A segment of the 10-mile Arkansas River Bicycle Path runs through the green space. Main roads in Indian Hills include McLean Boulevard, which winds north-south parallel to the river, as well as 13th Street and Central Avenue, both running east-west. Wichita Transit offers bus services on routes 12 and 15, providing transportation to the neighborhood.
