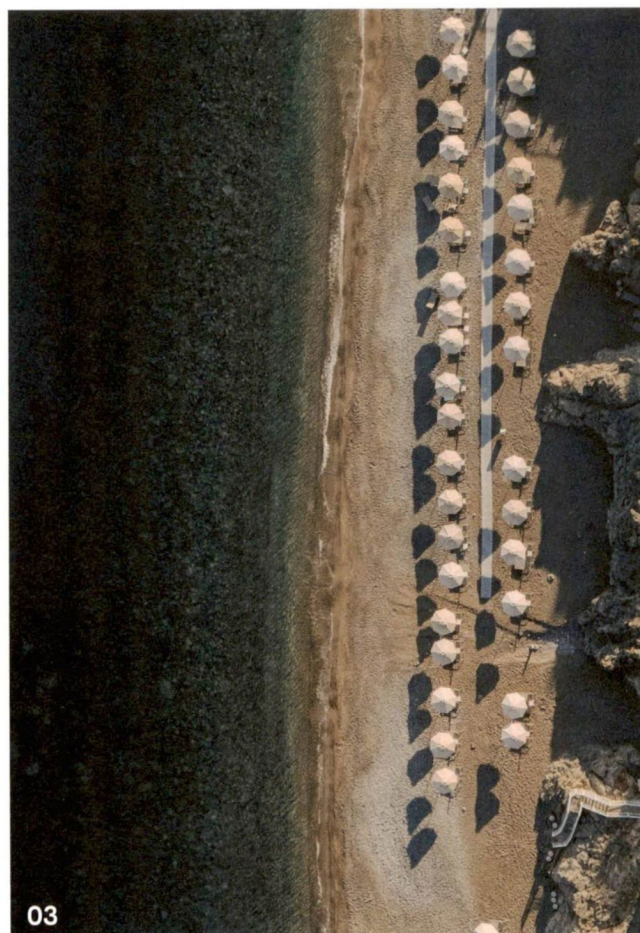

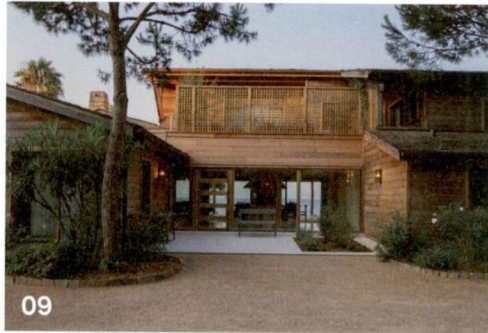
05 | Mountain Muse

10 | A River Hush

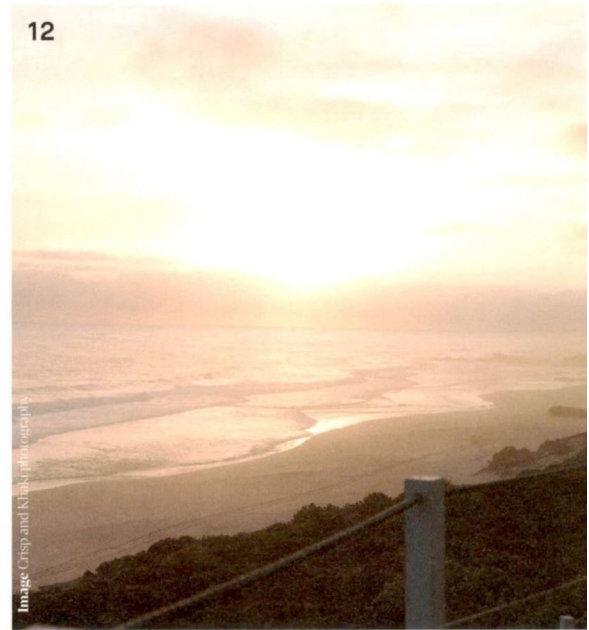
