If you need to cover an area larger than 180 feet in diameter, you can purchase additional transmitters and ensure the boundaries overlap by at least 30 feet. At least three feet away from metal objects, you should position the pet boundary area. If traveling in a metal RV or building with a metal roof, the maximum size of this area might need to be reduced. When arriving at your destination, mark the new area and don't forget to pack flags for your dog's visual reminder. Can I place the transmitter outside? No, it should be placed indoors where temperatures remain between -10°F and 104°F. Why not use this fence with dogs under six months old? The recommended age is based on cognitive development; puppies must be at least six months old, responding consistently to basic commands before using static correction collars for training.
