The Ethereal Visions tarot deck is an elegant and calming set of images inspired by art nouveau. It's based on the Waite-Smith tarot, with recognizable scenes and symbolism. The artwork features characters or groups against a simple background, often with mystical objects, maintained through a pastel palette. Artist Matt Hughes uses restrained earthy tones, except for the gold-foil illumination which brings out the unique Art Nouveau-inspired frames. The deck includes 80 fully illustrated cards: the traditional Major Arcana from The Fool to The World, along with two additional cards, The Well and The Artist. It has a standard size of 78 x 128 mm, with good card stock that's heavy but not flexible. The cards have a satin finish which keeps them smooth to shuffle and maintain their delicate color scheme. The print quality is excellent, with clear images and crisp lines. However, the gold foil is not sealed, making it vulnerable to scratches and scuffing. Handling the deck requires care, laying it on a cloth to prevent damage. The colors are mostly natural, but with dreamy blues and purples for more subjective scenes. The overall design and quality of the Ethereal Visions tarot deck make it stand out from other decks in its market. The Ethereal Visions Illuminated Tarot Deck features heavy black lines that are actually shiny gold foil, reflecting the artist's influence from Art Nouveau and Pre-Raphaelite art. The style is predominantly Art Nouveau, with sinuous lines and serene facial expressions. Each image has a unique gold frame, and titles are written in a classic Art Nouveau font. The deck's design on the back features twisting abstract circular designs in pink and lavender on a green leaf background, which is reversible. The cards come packaged in a solid cardboard box with lift-off lid, printed with images from the deck and publisher information. The box has a smooth finish and gold foil details. It includes a 45-page Little White Book written by the artist, providing instructions and information about the Major Arcana cards' astrological correspondences, descriptions, and divinatory meanings. The deck is designed for elegance and restraint, with a focus on tranquil mysticism. The Minor Arcana suits each have a small precis describing their astrological, elemental, and directional correspondences. Individual cards have both upright and reversed meanings, but no further information is provided.
