He is the Vicar of Christ and will remain on earth until the church returns to its heavenly home. Regarding baptism in water, we believe that it integrates disciples into the body of Christ, identifying them with His death and resurrection. It is for those who have believed and repented of their sins. The fivefold ministry is seen as the equipping of saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ until we reach the unity of faith and the knowledge of God's Son. This enables us to become mature men and women, fully equipped to achieve the fullness of Christ. Finally, regarding the rapture, we believe that it is a promise made by Jesus Christ to His church, where He will come for her and take her up to heaven to be with Him forever. The resurrection is also believed to be a divine act where God will raise all the dead, giving eternal life to believers and eternal condemnation to unbelievers.
