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Meditations on the Tarot is a nearly complete English version of the book, translated by Robert A. Powell and revised by Bradley Rader. The document is based on the original used since 1985 and contains non-textual elements that have been scarce in view since their creation in the mid-20th century. The text has some mistakes, both easily avoidable and more serious ones. For further information, please refer to the description available at archive.org. The document also includes newer introductions with additional explanations of recent discoveries, which can be found in larger files named 'mott 1 of 4', 'mott 2 of 4', etc., or 'mott complete'. These versions are updated and have clearer introductions but are larger due to the scanning at 600 dpi.
