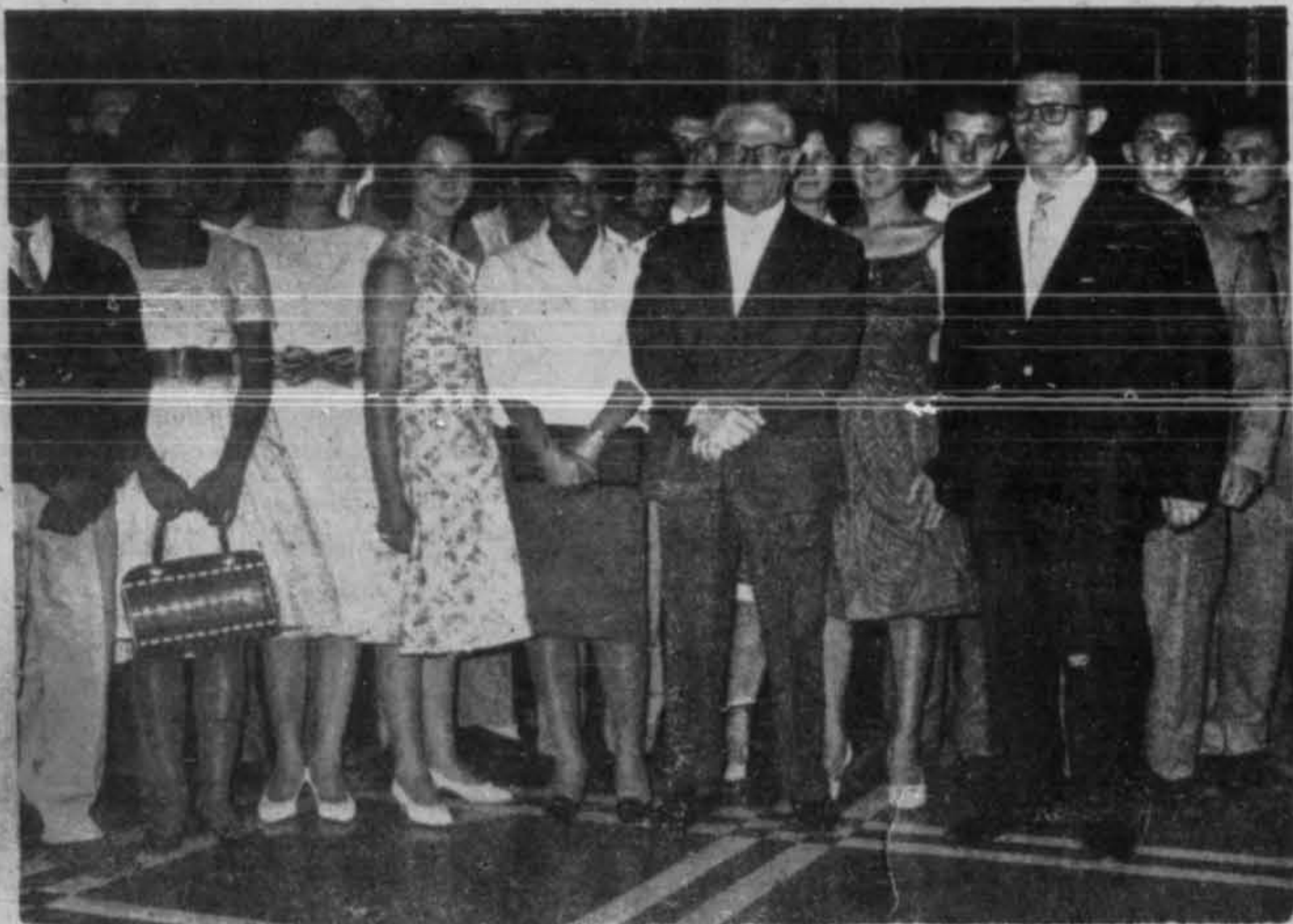

Ancora sui rapporti tra Vienna e Roma dopo il ricorso austriaco all'O.N.U.

Abbiamo presentato, ai nostri lettori, nei numeri scorsi, la questione da tempo accesa tra Roma e Vienna, intorno alle Minoranze tedesche in Alto Adige e, particolarmente, abbiamo parlato della onesta e precisa proposta del presidente del Consiglio Tambroni, per il deferimento della questione stessa al Tribunale Internazionale dell'Aja. Respinta la proposta Tambroni, il Governo di Vienna ha presentato al Segretario dell'ONU, richiesta di iscrizione nell'agenda della prossima assemblea generale del «Problema della minoranza austriaca in Italia». Il memorandum è basato essenzialmente sull'accusa all'Italia di rifiutarsi di concedere l'autonomia alla provincia di Bolzano.

Negli ambienti prossimi alla delegazione italiana si osserva che le trattative dirette austro-italiane si sono appunto arenate

per il fatto che da parte austriaca si continuava a negare che l'Italia avesse adempiuto agli obblighi dell'accordo De Gasperi-Gruber, per quanto riguarda la autonomia speciale della provincia di Bolzano, mentre le autorità italiane sono convinte di averlo rettamente applicato.

Di fronte a tale situazione, nella sua lettera del 22 giugno scorso al Cancelliere Raab, il Presidente Tambroni ha proposto o una vigorosa ripresa delle trattative dirette con un incontro ad alto livello, ovvero il deferimento della controversia, di comune accordo, all'esame ed alla decisione da parte della competente Corte di Giustizia dell'Aja. Del resto tale proposta costituisce anche un preciso invito alla doverosa osservanza da parte dei Governi di Vienna e di Roma di un obbligo reciproco che essi hanno liberamente assunto quando hanno sottoscritto la conven-

zione di Strasburgo che rende obbligatorio il deferimento alla Corte dell'Aja delle controversie tra i firmatari della convenzione stessa: questa è stata ratificata dal Parlamento italiano e austriaco e nel gennaio scorso gli strumenti di ratifica sono stati regolarmente depositati dai due Governi.

Invece, nel memorandum austriaco per l'iscrizione della questione nell'agenda dell'Assemblea generale dell'ONU la logica proposta italiana di adire la Corte Internazionale dell'Aja in ottemperanza all'obbligo sancito dalla convenzione di Strasburgo è totalmente ignorata, mentre si rifa, naturalmente in un senso favorevole alle rivendicazioni austriache, una cronistoria degli avvenimenti alto-atesini a partire dalla prima guerra mondiale.

Alle Nazioni Unite la decisione austriaca di portare la questione

dell'Alto Adige dinanzi al Tribunale Internazionale è stata commentata in un senso generalmente negativo. Viene rilevato in particolare che le parti non hanno esaurito una procedura specificamente prescritta dalla Carta e cioè le negoziazioni bilaterali per via diplomatica. Nei circoli occidentali si commenta che l'iniziativa del governo di Vienna è stata dettata soprattutto da considerazioni politiche interne, ciò che ridurrebbe ulteriormente la validità di un intervento societario. I Paesi comunisti potrebbero con difficoltà trovare, nella questione, materia per sfruttamento propagandistico dato che numerosi Paesi dell'Est, ma specialmente la Russia sovietica, sono società multinazionali in cui il problema delle minoranze è spesso assai acuto.

Il raccolto del grano in Italia è insufficiente

ROMA, 13 (ANSA) — L'indagine campionaria sul raccolto della campagna granaria è terminata. Secondo i dati giunti al Ministero dell'Agricoltura, la produzione raggiungerebbe i 73 milioni di quintali, cioè oltre 11 milioni meno di quella dell'anno scorso. Per il fabbisogno nazionale che è di 90 milioni, mancherebbero quindi 17 milioni di quintali.

Si tratta di un risultato negativo che nonostante l'andamento climatico sfavorevole dello scorso inverno, non era stato previsto sino alla fine di

maggio, quando lo stato delle colture lasciava prevedere un raccolto proporzionato a quello del 1959, che fu di 84 milioni e 400 mila quintali.

La situazione sarebbe facilmente superabile se non fossero esaurite le scorte di cui disponeva lo Stato negli scorsi anni.

Gli organi responsabili, tuttavia, ritengono che sia possibile acquistare all'estero il grano necessario tenero e duro a prezzi inferiori a quelli della produzione nazionale.



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THE LITTLE COURTESY GIRL

The neighborhood consisted of small shacks. The people living within were about the poorest ever to have been known. These were the times before the days of government relief. Little Tom Shotton was a small boy growing up in this environment. His clothes were mostly rags, in keeping with the other children attending school.

But there was a little girl who was different, not in dress but just "different". She was known by one and all as the "Little Courtesy Girl". She earned this name because of the way she would curtsy to every one who walked in to the little corner store before inquiring of their needs. She was adopted by Mrs. Cadwar who owned the small establishment, and she must have, because of her manner, spent her earlier years in an entirely different environment. Little Tom's mother and father both died not long after the adoption of this child by Mrs. Cadwar. He was sent to live with his uncle in New York.

Tom was 13 years old now, old enough to be a "shill" for his uncle who was a New York pitchman. After Uncle John (for that was his name) would make his spiel, Little Tom would be the first to purchase what ever he was selling over the soapbox, then walking around the corner would come back and buy more.

As it was already stated, this was during the Depression days, so a pitchman and his shill had to live in "flop houses", where they could pay for their room in the only manner they were able, every night.

By the time Tom was 18 his uncle also passed away. But he had become acquainted enough with this type of thing, to get a job making a spiel, and was in charge of the prize candy boxes that were sold in one of Minsky's burlesque houses. He considered this above the street pitchman's social level, and it was. Although being in Hell's kitchen, he now had a private room. This is more than he had ever had before.

The boys working with him in the burlesque house bragged about business picking up because of the new guest star who was a stripper known as The Duchess. Those who had seen her in other house vowed she'd "pack 'em in." So everything seemed just hotys totsy for our little Tom, because he worked a commission basis.

The new guest star packed in alright, but turned out



to be none other than "the Little Courtesy Girl". Tom was never so unhappy in all his life. He, like his boyhood neighbors, had looked upon the Little Courtesy Girl with awe, admiration and respect, thinking that some day she would, be a great lady. Not that Tom didn't think a strip teaser wasn't alright in every respect. But it just was not for The Little "Courtesy Girl."

He contacted her after the first show, told her how disappointed he was but her only answer was: "a girl has to live." Well, this wasn't any way for The Little Courtesy Girl to provide for her living, thought Tom. He set out to be sure that things would be different. Tom's own morals were not too high, through his environment he was taught that a dollar made, regardless of how, as long as you were not caught, was alright. First, he bought some candy boxes of his own, stuffed silk paper into them with candies, making the same amount of candy fill twice as many boxes. This way he put half the money that would have gone to Minsky into his own pockets. His sole ambition was to provide enough so that the Little Courtesy Girl would not have to work as a strip teaser.

Tom was caught, some one had nose trouble, and gave away his scheme. He was tried before one of the meanest judges on the Bronx circuit, a man never to be known to have smiled. His only pleasure seemed in sentencing poor, helpless human beings.

The Little Duchess was in court to help Tom in any way she possibly could. She was not only attractive as a strip teaser but she still possessed all the beauty, manners and character of a lady who charmed all who looked upon her. The judge, for the first time, was interested in something else than giving a drastic sentence. When the Little Courtesy Girl spoke in Tom's behalf the judge could easily see where Tom could do no wrong. The case was dismissed. But his attention shown to "The Little Courtesy Girl" was never dismissed. And, a few weeks after this trial she became his wife. Tom who succeeded in a respectable business, having been helped by this same judge, vows "that those who are willing to help others will be helped."

IMMIGRATION AND NATURALIZATION

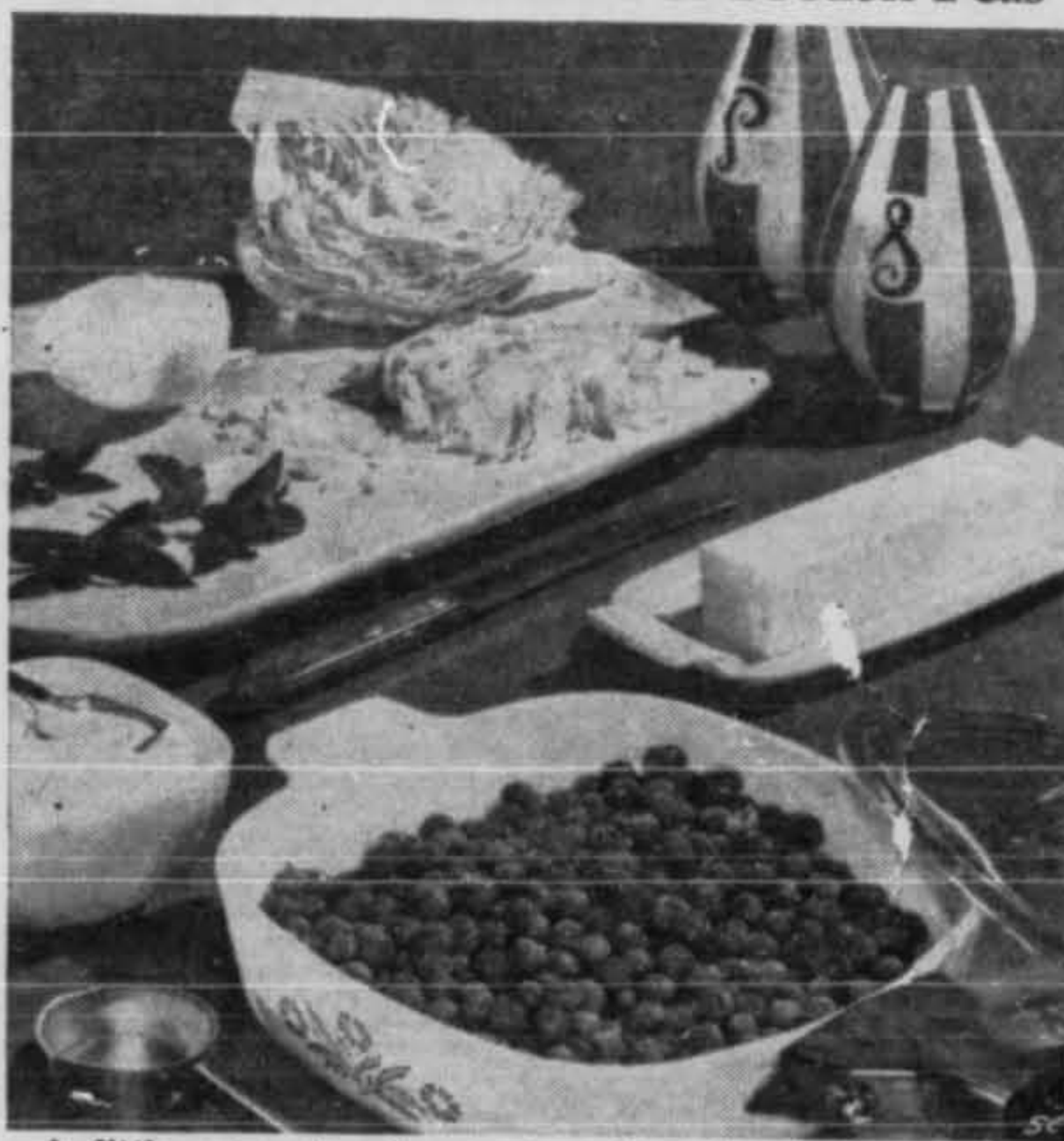
To Which Country's Immigration Quota Will My Cousin Be Charged?

QUESTION:

A cousin of mine wants to come to the United States. He was born in a town in Europe which belonged to one country at the time he was born, but now belongs to another. I would like to know to what quota he will be charged. Will it be the quota of the country to which his birthplace belonged at the time of his birth, or to the country to which is now belongs?

ANSWER:

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Frozen Green Peas, French Style

| 1 10-ounce package frozen green peas | 2 teaspoons finely minced onion |
| 2 tablespoons water | 1 small sprig mint |
| 1/2 teaspoon salt | 1/2 head lettuce, shredded |
| 1/2 teaspoon sugar | 1 tablespoon butter |
| | 2 tablespoons cream |

Drop frozen peas into saucepan with the water, salt, sugar, onion and mint. Cover and bring to a boil quickly over high heat separating the block of frozen peas with a fork, if necessary, to hasten thawing (takes 2 to 3 minutes). When peas are separated, add half of lettuce under the peas and place remainder on top. Cover, reduce heat to medium, just enough to keep peas simmering gently, and cook until peas are just tender, about 5 minutes. Add butter and cream and serve at once. Yield: 3 servings.

Greetings

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In general, an alien will be charged to the quota of the country in which his birthplace is now located. The fact that his place of birth was formerly in another country is immaterial, provided that the transfer of territory has been recognized by the United States. Citizenship is also immaterial. For example, an alien born in a town which was formerly in Austria but is now in Italy would be chargeable to the Italian quota, even though he is now living in Austria and is now a citizen of Austria.

When I Become A Citizen, Will My Wife and Son Be Citizens Also?

QUESTION:

Five years ago I arrived in the United States with my wife and son as an immigrant and now would like to apply for citizenship. I would like to know whether my wife and son will become citizens automatically when I become a citizen.

ANSWER::

Your becoming a citizen will have no effect whatsoever on the citizenship status of your wife. She will have to apply for naturalization on her own. Even your son's citizenship status will not be affected unless both you and your wife are naturalized. In that case, he will derive American citizenship, provided he entered the United States before he was 16 years old and that both you and your wife have been naturalized prior to

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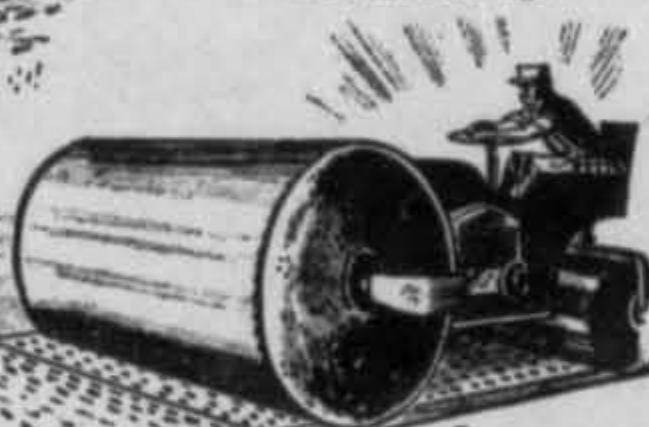

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Burial Denied To Negligent Auto Drivers

Refusal of Christian burial to Catholics found criminally negligent in auto mishaps was decreed by the Bishop of Lafayette, La.

Bishop Maurice Schexnayder of Lafayette issued the decree following what he termed "a mounting excess" in automotive negligence.

The Bishop's action is the latest of many appeals and instructions from Church leaders, including His Holiness Pope John XXIII, aimed at curtailing excessive negligence on the highways.

In his decree, Bishop Schexnayder cited the "grave moral responsibilities" which rest upon the shoulders of drivers.

He said these responsibilities should express themselves in "vigilance, caution, and observation of traffic laws designed to minimize the danger of accidents."

"Most tragic of all," Bishop Schexnayder said, "are those accidents which are the result of drivers' negligence, often gravely criminal."

The Bishop stated in the decree that those "drivers of vehicles who are declared by competent police officials to have been criminally negligent in highway accidents resulting in death to themselves, are not to be given Christian burial."

In a March 9, 1959, message to motor vehicle operators, Pope John urged drivers to show respect for human life by obeying traffic regulations. He stated: "The anxiety to reach earthly destinations quickly must not... make travelers lose sight of the road to eternal salvation."

In a statement adopted at their annual general meeting in November, 1957, the U.S. Bishops urged that "every driver reflect upon the moral obligations he assumes, when he takes the wheel of a car. They added: "Carelessness, neglect or reckless conduct" by a driver are "sinful," the statement said.

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Senate Authorizes Medals For Dorchester Chaplains

The U.S. Senate has passed a bill to authorize posthumous medals and certificates for four chaplains who died in the World War II sinking of the USS Dorchester.

Without a dissenting voice, the Senate passed and sent to the House of Representatives a bill (S-2969) co-sponsored by Sens. Styles Bridges of New Hampshire and Stuart Symington of Missouri.

The four chaplains were Father John P. Washington of the Newark, N.J. archdiocese; the Rev. Mr. George L. Fox and the Rev. Mr. Clark V. Poling, both Protestants; and Rabbi Alexander D. Goode.

The Dorchester was torpedoed off Greenland in February, 1943. After helping others escape from the sinking ship, the chaplains gave their life jackets to four young soldiers and then went down with the ship.

Egli è stato scelto nel corso di una colazione data in onore di senatori degli Stati del Sud e del Confine dai senatori John F. Kennedy e Lyndon B. Johnson.

La colazione, la prima di tre che i candidati del partito daranno per i loro colleghi del Senato, era destinata a stimolare appoggi nel Sud per i candidati democratici alla presidenza e vice presidenza.

Quasi tutti i senatori erano presenti, compreso Richard B. Russell e Herman E. Talmadge della Georgia, che non appoggiano i candidati.

Assenti erano i senatori Harry F. Byrd del Virginia e J. Strom Thurmond, gli altri due dissidenti tra i senatori del Sud.

Il chairman democratico nazionale Henry M. Jackson ha detto che la loro assenza non è "significativa". Egli ha anche detto di ritenere che non c'è dubbio sul fatto che Russell e Talmadge finiranno con l'appoggiare i candidati.

Jackson ha rivelato che Smathers, chairman del Comitato Democratico Senatoriale per la Campagna, dirigerà la campagna nel Sud.

Egli ha detto che Smathers non ha ancora deciso dove stabilire la sua base di operazioni, ma che lavorerà in stretta collaborazione con i senatori, congressman e leaders del partito negli Stati del Sud.

The Vatican's art museums including the painter, Filippo De Pisis, and the sculptor, Pericle Fazzini. There is also a painting of French churches by Maurice Utrillo, a painting by Georges Rouault and a small bronze cast of "The Thinker" by Auguste Rodin.

The 21 paintings and eight sculptures are on display in two new rooms opened in the Vatican picture gallery. The rooms are devoted to art works produced since 1850. Only two of the new works have a religious subject. Most of the new additions are the works of Italian artists, including the painter, Filippo De Pisis, and the sculptor, Pericle Fazzini. There is also a painting of French churches by Maurice Utrillo, a painting by Georges Rouault and a small bronze cast of "The Thinker" by Auguste Rodin.

All of the new works have been donated to the Vatican museum. Among the donors was Georges Rouault.

Artists in Flower Petals

The people of Genzano, a town in the hills outside of Rome, say it with flowers—hundreds of thousands of them—for the annual Corpus Christi procession. One day a year the main street of Genzano becomes a carpet of colors. In less than four hours the quarter-mile-long street is transformed into a kaleidoscope made of millions of flower petals.

When the pattern is completed, a priest carries the Blessed Sacrament down the full length of the steep street to the cathedral below. The copes of the priest and his two assistants are shortened so as not to disturb the delicate designs. All three are careful not to walk on the most complex details of the flower pictures.

The townspeople of Genzano have been creating their one-day work of art for three centuries. Ever since 1765 when the custom was begun, the people of Genzano have passed down from father to son their designs and the right to certain sections of the street.

The Natural Look: Summary

To be really well-groomed, it is suggested that you look yourself over in a cold, unfriendly way every now and then. But this is just an occasional thing, designed to spot flaws. It is not recommended as a good mental condition! Instead, you should 'think beauty.' When you feel beautiful, you walk taller and an aura of poise and grace surrounds you. Something magical happens.

This magic is hard to explain, but easy to prove. Stop for a moment and think of your good points . . . think of yourself as



beautiful. Now — didn't you sit taller, hold your head erect, feel your facial muscles relax? Of course you did. And then you became beautiful. Such thoughts can make you care for yourself as a beauty, act like a beauty, convince others that you are a beauty.

In this series, we've told you how to disguise your bad points. We'd like to emphasize a few notable exceptions. Many clever and fascinating women stress their bad points instead of hiding them. Conventional prettiness may be a matter of following the rules; true beauty is a matter of breaking them. Consider the actresses you admire. How many are per-

fect in every feature? Very few. Many of them draw attention to flaws — an over-large mouth, a long neck, a prominent nose. Even protruding eyes and crooked teeth can become assets. Making the most of bad points is an exciting—but dangerous—business. It takes time, brains, courage. You can try it, always remembering that you can duck back to the safety of the conventional rules.

Grooming, in any event, takes more time than money. But don't start without the proper tools: lotions and creams, a good hair brush, a rotary electric shaver such as the Coquette, and carefully selected makeup. Plus — now and then — professional advice.

Good grooming (the beauty that you create) should be routine. Once established, it becomes a quick and easy habit. It is for all the time — not just gala occasions. No matter how well you look at a party, your friends will remember how you looked in the office or at the market.

Finally . . . remember that your goal is an over-all beauty. This includes more than a good figure and an attractive face. It means a soft voice, good posture, a pleasant expression, a gracious handshake. It means, too, such mundane but important things as well-polished shoes, straight stocking seams and immaculate clothes.

Have you followed all the rules? My — how pretty you look!

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
