

## Direct-To-Deck Installation

Coronado Vents are designed to be installed with either a batten system or direct-to-deck with no battens. Both methods are acceptable and compatible with Coronado Vents.

When installing Flat Coronado Vents direct-to-deck, it is recommended to use our "Vegas Style" primary vent, which feature a slightly lower vertical leg (.08" vs a true 1.00"), and allows the secondary vent and tile to lay flat. The standard primary vents can still be used in a direct-to-deck installation, however it may cause the secondary vent to sit slightly higher – this is cosmetic issue, not a waterproofing issue.

**Hole Placement:** It is required that the primary vent hole be cut .5" ~ .75" (not to exceed 1") above the tile lay line - see below.
