Students can choose from a diverse range of academic disciplines, including Arts and Humanities, Business and Economics, Law, Medicine, Engineering, Technology, and Creative Writing. Through hands-on projects, seminar-style debates, and immersive learning experiences, you'll gain analytical skills and insights that extend far beyond the classroom. These programs help you build academic confidence, strengthen your university applications, and explore your future goals — all while learning in one of the world's most inspiring academic settings.



#### Featured Course Highlights

- English Literature and Creative Writing Students will explore classic and contemporary literature, learning how to create compelling characters, develop engaging plots, and find their own writing style. They'll study the power of language and poetry while improving their ability to communicate ideas clearly and creatively.
- Biotechnology and Genetics Gain a solid foundation in biotechnology and genetics, understanding how
  these fields are changing the world and shaping the future. Students will explore key breakthroughs in
  medicine, pharmacology, and agriculture, learning about cell biology, genetic engineering, and the
  ethical questions raised by these technologies.
- Medicine Through a combination of theory and hands-on study, students will gain a deep understanding
  of cell biology and its connection to the human body, providing them with a foundational knowledge of
  modern medicine. The course will also look at how understanding normal bodily functions is crucial for
  tackling diseases and how ongoing research is pushing the boundaries of medical treatment.

#### Get to Know Our Students

Our Cambridge Summer School is designed for students aged 13-24, catering to a wide range of academic interests and career goals. Whether you are interested in exploring new subjects or deepening your understanding of a particular field, our expert tutors provide a personalised and enriching learning experience. Students are divided into three age groups to ensure that the programme meets their developmental needs. For Advanced Courses, applicants must be aged 18-24 and have completed at least two years of undergraduate study (or equivalent) by the course start date.







#### For Ages: 13-15

Staying in the City of Cambridge offers a wide range of experiences. Guided city tours and orientations led by our dedicated staff help students settle in, while daily activities and excursions provide fun, learning, and the chance to explore local culture. Group projects, free time with peers, and evening events like Bop and formal dinners foster connection and confidence in a unique and supportive setting.
